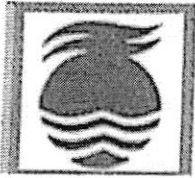

Karnataka Forest Department may address this issue technically and suggest silviculturally sound Package of Practices for raising Compensatory Afforestation as desired by IRO, MOEFCC, Bangalore. KNNL is ready to bear the additional cost towards the same, if any.
2.	Since the project site is falling in the Tiger Corridor, CWLW may consider incorporating suitable mitigation measures in the Mitigation plan and the requirements prescribed under MoEF&CC Guidelines dated 17/5/22 in such cases.	As per the OM Dt: 17.05.2022, application seeking SBWL/NBWL recommendation has been uploaded in Parivesh portal on 31.05.2023 vide proposal no. WL/KA/DRKWATER/431333/2023 and the acknowledgment is enclosed as Annexure-1 .

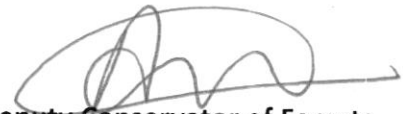

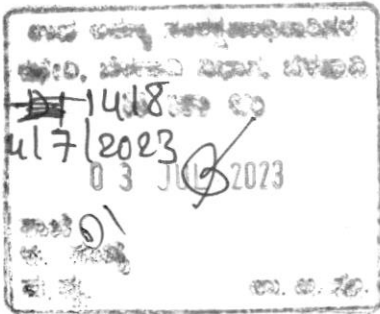
With reference to the above subject & reference, CA area identified in Halalli Sy No.66 of Athani taluk receives average annual rain fall of 538-559 mm and has very little natural vegetation, Keeping the above factors in mind, Big size poly bags ie 14*20 with 1*1*1 m pit size is chosen to be suitable for planting. This along with watering provisions that is included within the datasheet, soil & moisture conservation measures and overall protection in terms of chain link fencing can result in raising good plantation & forest in future.

Hence, The CA scheme proposed now from this office meets the silvicultural requirement for afforestation in dry area.
