Subject: Diversion of 5.828 hectare of forest land in favour of HPPWD for C/o of link road from Jabbal ka bag, Kandaiwala, Kharkon Km 0/0 to 12/255, within jurisdiction of Nahar Forest Division Distt. Sirmour. Online Proposal No. FP/HP/ROAD/140946/2021.

2. The point wise reply to the observations as raised your above referred communication is submitted as below:-

- Forwarding letter has been uploaded PARIVESH portal.
- In this connection user agency has intimated that wrong KML file was erroneously uploaded earlier on the PARIVESH portal. Now, the fresh and final KML file has been uploaded. The FCA proposal is in 2 No. patches due to the geographical condition as well as existing road approaches. The proposed road proposal will take off from existing Road Nahar Gadda at RD 0/500. The proposed road will connect the habitation Gadpela and Amaraion at RD 4/120 and terminates at existing road Sainwala Burma Papri road at RD 7/745. The Jabbal ka Bag Kandaiwala Kharkon road will once again take off from the existing road Sainwala Burma Papri road at RD 8/925 which start at Sainwala and finally terminates at village Kharkon at Km 12/255. The Revised Digital map, KML file and toposheet have been uploaded in appropriate column. The total length of proposed alignment is 12.255 Km with average width of 6.00 meter. The road alignment passes through forest and private land. The portion from Km 0/0 to 3/200, 3/735 to 4/650, 9/465 to 12/255 will be passing through forest land and portion from Km 3/200 to 3/735, 4/650 to 9/465 will pass through private land. Total 3 No. dumping sites have selected. Excavated earth will be dumped on valley side at RD. 2/105 to 2/175 & 10/465 to 10/530 in forest land which includes 1.685 Hectare additional area of forest land. Total forest 5.828 Hectare area are required for construction of this project.1 No. dumping site has been proposed in the private land at RD. 6/810 to 6/880 which includes 0.91 hectare additional land. Revised Digital Map has been uploaded in additional information at Sr. No. 26 of Part-I. Revised topo sheet has been uploaded in additional information at Sr. No. 25 of Part-I.
- Joint inspection report has already been uploaded in additional information detail against Sr. No. 8 of Part-I by user agency. However site inspection report has been uploaded in appropriate column by this office.

- Undertaking for Soil and Moisture conservation plan has been uploaded by the user agency in additional information against Sr. No. 30 of Part-I.
- Needful has been done by user agency. An undertaking in respect of FRA certificates along with annexure submission of FRC and Gram Sabha has been uploaded in additional information at Sr. No. 22 of Part-I.
- In this connection user agency has submitted that after FCA clearance, the Private land owners have agreed to gift their land in favour of HPPWD for this road project. NOC in this regard has been given by the land owners has been uploaded in additional information against Sr. No. 23 of Part-I.
- In this connection user agency has intimated that two dumping sites have been proposed in the forest area due to unavoidable circumstances and involved minimum area. The private land owners are not ready to allow dumped the muck into their agriculture land. Only 1 dumping site has proposed in the non-forest land.
- In this context user agency has intimated that the dumping sites has been selected with care to no damages to agriculturists as well as to save the exists vegetate on in forest. Revised KML File has been uploaded in Column C of Part-I.
- Needful has been done by user agency. Revised KML File has been uploaded in Column C of Part-I.
- Needful has been done user agency. The Layout plan has been prepared which shows all the component (forest land/Non forest land) duly authenticated by the DFO. Copy of the same has been uploaded in additional information against Sr. No. 24 of Part-I.
- Needful has been done by user agency. The Layout plan showing chain-age wise length and width of forest and non-forest land has uploaded in additional information against Sr. No. 21 of Part-I.
- In this connection user agency has intimated that total length of the road is 12.555 Km. which passes through the forest and private land. The shortest and economically route has been finalized to connect the unconnected habitation of the Nahan town. The alternative routes also were explored, but not found feasible due to more involvement of trees as well as forest land.
- In this connection user agency has intimated that total length of the road is 12.555 Km. which passes through the forest and private land. Hence trees could not be reduced from the proposed area and enumeration list has been uploaded in additional information.

- NPV bill has been revised and same has been uploaded in additional information against Sr. No. 8 of Part-II.
- (I). As per report of DFO CA area is fit for plantation. Moreover in the CA area covered lantana bushes and kronnda jhari growing in the CA

area. Report has been uploaded in additional information against Sr. 6 of Part –II by DFO.

(II). CA Scheme has been revised and same has been uploaded on PARIVESH Portal in Part –II at serial no. 13 (ii) by DFO.

(III). Land Suitability certificate has been uploaded PARIVESH Portal in Part –II at serial no. 13 (V) by DFO.
