## SITE INSPECTION REPORT

A Proposal has been received by this office from **Executive Engineer**, **PWD WD-I**, **Fort Area**, **Moti Daman**(User Agency) for diversion (under FCA,1980) of **0.97 ha**. of forest land for non forestry purpose for **Sea front Road Development at Jampore Beach** in the UT of Daman. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on 01.09.2017 along with the representatives of the User Agency and the Range Forest officer, Daman Range.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a reserve forest measuring 0.97 ha. having casurina plantation raised in linear strips. The details of forest area along with the survey number proposed for diversion are as under: -

The requirement of the forest land as proposed by the user agency in part-I is unavoidable and is the barest minimum required for the project.

The status of the land is a Reserved Forest and has casurina trees. The said forest area proposed for diversion does not have any endangered/endemic flora and fauna.

Also, the user agency has not violated any of the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been taken up in the said forest area.

Hence, this proposal for diversion of 0.97 ha forest land for the purpose of Sea front Road Development close to Jampore Beach in the UT of Daman is **hereby recommended**.
