outlay of 16.02 Core for 10 years @ Rs 326/MD.

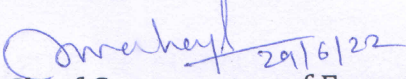

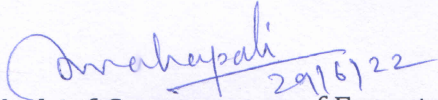
