The point wise reply of the observation as pointed out vide letter under reference has been attended as under:-

State Govt. shall rectify the vegetation density, which is currently 1.033 (at Sr.No.4(i) of Part II) and accordingly revise the NPV bill/calculation sheet, duly authenticated by DFO concerned.	<p>As per HP forest department notification No.FFE-B-C(8)1/2002 dated 09-01-2004(Photocopy enclosed), it is stated that a charge of Net Present Value earlier called environmental value of forest land diverted for non-forestry use on following terms:-</p> <p>Forest having less than 10% forest cover = Rs. 10,69,470 (Eco Class-VI)</p> <p>Forest having forest cover between 10-40% = Rs. 13,72,410 (--do---)</p> <p>Forest having more than 40% forest cover = Rs. 15,16,230 (---do---)</p> <p>The calculation of NPV purpose -forest having equal to or more than 400 trees per Ha.of class III and above and for young forest crops having equal to or more than 800 plants. The bill for Net Present Value amounting to Rs. 11,28,533 had been charged as per the details given below:-</p> <p>Total Area = 0.8223 Ha.</p> <p>(A) Total Nos of trees of III,II,I class = 15</p> <p>(B) Total Nos of trees IV & V class = 36</p> <p>(C) 2 trees of class IV and V area consider as one big trees 36/2 =18</p> <p>Total Nos of trees in 0.8223 hac area A(15)+C(18) = 33</p> <p>Density = $\frac{A+C}{Total\ area} \times \frac{1}{4} = \frac{33}{0.8223} \times \frac{1}{4} = 10.03\ rounded\ of\ 10\ %$</p> <p>33:-0.8223=40.131:-4 = 10.03% As per above calculation though the forest cover calculated by 10.03% and it was rounded off to 10% and rate of 13,72,410/- per hac. (10% to 40%) for Eco class VI) was charged and NPV bill amounting to Rs 11,28,533 is in order. (If forest density is equal to 1, it is considered to be 100% forest cover, then a forest cover of 10.03% corresponds to 0.1 forest density. This correction has been uploaded at Sr. No. 4(i) of Part-II." Revised NVP bill is uploaded against additional information of Part-II)</p>

The Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to impose charge of Net Present Value, earlier called environmental value of forest land diverted for non forest use on following terms:-

Forests having less than 10% forest cover.

Rs. 5.80 lakh
per hect.

Now Rs. 6,99,000/-

Forests having forest cover between 10-40%

Rs. 7.50 lakh
per hect.

Forests having more than 40% forest cover.

For the purpose of determining the forest cover, 100% forest cover is defined as under:-

- ii. For mature forests:- Forests having equal to or more than 400 trees per hectare of class III and above.
- For young forest crops (regeneration or plantation areas) - forests having equal to or more than 800 plants per hectare of less than class III. [For mixed crop (mature and young) the total number of trees shall be worked out by taking one mature tree equal to two young trees or vice versa].

The aforesaid value is to be paid by the user agency. The Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to order that this notification is applicable w.e.f. 30th October, 2002 in pursuance to the orders dated 20/10/2002 & 01/11/2003 of Hon'ble Supreme Court in O.A. No. 566 under C.F.T. and orders dated 1993 titled as T.N. Googayman Vs Union of India.

Accordingly this Departmental notification of even no. date
24-6-2002 remain operative up to 29-10-2002 only.
