Sub: Diversion of 6.56 ha of forest land for construction of Bolangir Bypass Road (West) by the Executive Engineer, NH Division, Bolangir under Bolangir Forest Division – Compliance to GoI observations regarding.

Ref: Letter F.No.5-ORC603/2023- BHU dated 29.09.2023 of Deputy Inspector General of Forests (C), GoI, MoEF & CC, Regional Office, Bhubaneswar.

Sir,

In inviting a reference to GoI, MoEF & CC, Regional Office, Bhubaneswar letter cited above on the captioned subject, the compliance basing on the reports of DFO, Bolangir Forest Division and RCCF, Bhawanipatna Circle are as follows:

Observation (a):- The DFO, Bolangir has reported that no violation has been committed by the user agency under F.C. Act, 1980. However, as per DSS analysis, violation is observed in some portion of forest land proposed for diversion. Detail action taken report & extent of forest area used under violation of FC Act, 1980 along with name and designation of erring officials responsible for violation causing diversion of forest land for non-forestry purpose may be furnished.

<u>Compliance:</u> The RCCF, Bhawanipatna Circle has furnished the copy of the compliance report submitted by the Executive Engineer, Bolangir N.H. Division which is enclosed herewith as **Annexure-I**.

Observation (b):- The concerned Tahasildar has not furnished non-encroachment & non-encumbrance certificate of CA land identified with the proposal. Agricultural activities and un-metalled road are observed in CA patches. This may be clarified by the State Govt. in view of the suitability of CA land and encroachment free land.

<u>Compliance</u>: The RCCF, Bhawanipatna Circle has furnished the non-encroachment & non-encumbrance certificate of the Compensatory Afforestation land identified for the above project duly signed by the Tahasildar-cum-Executive Magistrate, Bolangir, DFO, Bolangir and others which is enclosed as **Annexure-II**.

Observation (c):- The user agency has not furnished KML file of entire proposed road alignment with the proposal.

<u>Compliance</u>: The RCCF, Bhawanipatna Circle has furnished the KML file of entire proposed road alignment submitted by the Executive Engineer, Bolangir N.H. Division which is appended in a pen drive.

This is for favour of kind information and necessary action.

Submission of Compliance for Diversion of 6.56 ha. of forest land for construction of Balangir By-pass -Reg.

Sir,

In inviting a kind reference to the subject cited above, it is to submit herewith the point-wise compliance to the objections raised by Dy. Inspector General of Forest (C), MoEF & CC, Integrated Regional Office, Bhubaneswar as below.

1. As per DSS analysis, violation has been observed in some portions of forest land proposed for Diversion

- (a) In Balangir By-pass road, three numbers of Revenue villages are coming, namely Puintala, Bishnumunda & Bijakhaman. Out of a total area of 69.15 ha. required for construction of NH Bypass Road, the revenue forest area comes to be 6.56Ha spread across 23 nos. of patches. However, in DSS analysis/Google imagery, violations on revenue forest land are observed at 8 nos. of plots. This is due to the absence of any clear demarcation between forest and non forest land. So, while preparing for the execution of work and during vehicular movement in the private land, the fly ash was mistakenly spread over adjoining revenue forest land which was later removed completely without harming any vegetation.
- (b) In Bijakhaman village, the revenue forest in plot No- 1733 & 1712, the land is temporarily being used as Truck parking during the no-entry period to Balangir Town from 6.00 AM to 10.00 PM. The track path shown in plot No-1486&1525 is actually a footpath, used by the local villagers since long back.
- (c) In Bishnumunda village, the revenue forest in plot No-1120 & 843, it has occurred due to the reason as mentioned in 1(a).
- (d) In Puintala village, the revenue forest in plot No-1172 & 1187, it has occurred due to the same reason as mentioned in 1(a). Geo-tagged photographs of all the plots are enclosed herewith for kind appraisal.



2. The non-encroachment and non-encumbrance certificate of the Compensatory Afforestation land identified for the above project from Tahasildar, Balangir is required.

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The non-encroachment and non-encumbrance certificate of the Compensatory Afforestation land identified for the above project has been submitted by Tahasildar, Balangir.(point no2) (Enclosed).

3. The KML file of the entire proposed road alignment.

The KML file of the entire proposed road alignment is submitted in a pen drive (Enclosed).

In view of the above, it is requested to consider the case and take the necessary steps for processing the diversion proposal in the larger public interest.

Consequent upon receipt of Memo No-21031/FE&CC, Date.07.10.2023 of OSD-cum-Special Secretary to Government in Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department, and as per instruction of Divisional Forest Officer, Balangir Forest Division, I have made inspection to the 6.56 Ha of Revenue Forest Land proposed for diversion for construction of Balangir By- pass road by NH Division Balangir, in presence of Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Balangir on dt. 28.10.2023.

In Balangir By-pass road, to be constructed by NH Division, Balangir, three numbers of revenue villages are coming namely Puintala, Bishnumunda & Bijakhaman. Out of total area of 69.15 ha required for construction, the Revenue Forest area comes to be 6.56 ha, spread across 23 nos of patches.

Observations

In the Google imagery, violations are observed in 8 nos of plots. In the field, there is no clear demarcation between forest and non forest land. As ascertained from the KML file, during vehicular movement in the private land, the fly ash was spread over adjoining forest area. Later on, the fly ash has been removed. Presently, there is no permanent construction in the said area. The geotagged photographs are submitted herewith for favour of your kind perusal.
