Sub - Proposal under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 Diversion of 3.7835 ha. Forest land of Village Kumbharoshi, Jawali, Haroshi and Malkampeth, Tal.-Mahabaleshwar, Dist. Satara for Mahapratap Ropeway from Mahabaleshwar to Pratapgad.

The Chief Executive Officer, SAIO, INFRA, Kolhapur has submitted the proposal for diversion of 3.7835 ha Reserve Forest, under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, in Villages Kumbhroshi, Javali, Haroshi and Malkampeth, Tal. Mahabaleshwar, Dist. Satara for Mahapratap Ropeway Project, Mahabaleshwar in the State of Maharashtra. The details of forest land proposed for diversion are as shown below.

The proposed Aerial Tourist Ropeway shall be developed at Mahabaleshwar, District Satara, Maharashtra from the Pratapgad Fort to Village Javali and Village Javali to Lodwick point at Mahabaleshwar. The land for proposed Ropeway comes partly under forest land 3.7835 ha and partly under Non-forest land 2.052 ha. Thus, 3.7835 ha of forest land needs to be diverted for construction of ropeway. The diversion of forest land will be required for construction of two terminal stations, 14 towers, & ropeway corridor along the ropeway alignment.

Following things were observed while scrutinizing the proposal and the reports sent by DCF Satara and User Agency.

- 1. The percentage of forest land actually to be utilized in the ground for erection of towers, upper and lower terminal station is 11.31%.
- 2. On analyzing the list of the tree to be felled, it is found that around 90% of tree enumerated have girth less than 60 cm. and average height 3-5 m.
- 3. User Agency has agreed to handover 3.80 ha at Village Chaturbet, Tal. Mahabaleshwar, Dist. Satara for Compensatory Afforestation. The said area falls in Mahabaleshwar-Pachagani Region Eco-Sensitive Zone (ESZ), and consists of more than 60% area under tree cover. In addition to it, DCF Satara suggested the User Agency to take Compensatory Afforestation in degraded forest land over an area of 3.80 ha at Village Nirgude, Tal. Phaltan, Dist. Satara. User Agency also agreed to take up C.A. in degraded forest land.
- 4. The project area doesn't fall in Protected Area or ESZ of the Protected Areas.
- 5. The project area falls in Mahabaleshwar-Pachagani Region Eco-Sensitive Zone (ESZ).
- 6. The project area falls in ESA of Western Ghat as per draft notification dated 6.07.2022.
- 7. The ropeway project may reduce the vehicular mode of transport significantly, which may result in a substantial reduction in carbon emissions.
- 8. The Aerial Ropeway Advisory Board has been constituted as per Bombay Arial Ropeways Act 1955. The Board will scrutinize the ropeway proposal, submitted by the User Agency, along with the NOC obtained from various State/Central Govt. authorities and the board may or may not recommend to the State Govt. for final approval.

Considering all the above mentioned facts, CCF (T), Kolhapur Circle recommends the proposal, subject to the approval by the High Level Monitoring Committee (HLMC) constituted for Mahabaleshwar-Panchgani Region Eco-Sensitive Zone (ESZ).

As desired by the GOI, MOEF&CC, Regional Office (WCZ), Nagpur vide reference 1, DCF Satara vide letter dated 20.12.2023 submitted the query compliance. After studying the query compliance report sent by DCF Satara, CCF (T), Kolhapur submits the query compliance as shown below.
