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With reference to the above subject, the forest proposal No: FP/KA/TRANS/42309/2019 has been submitted from the User Agency for Re diversion and Fresh diversion of 4.0394 Ha of forest land in Sy No: 97, 98, 99, 82, 83 and in river course of K.Kanaburu village and Sy No: 73 in Muthinakoppa village of N.R.Pura taluk, Chikkamagaluru district for laying of 220Kv transmission line for Upper Bhadra Project. Vide reference (3), EDS query has been received from the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Conservation), Bengaluru regarding the diversion and Re-diversion area in the proposal, CA land and Legal Status of the forest land.

The Range Forest Officer, Narasimharajapura Range, N.R.Pura and Assistant Conservator of Forest and TA to Deputy Conservator of Forests, Koppa Division, Koppa has submitted the report in the ref (4) and (5) cited above.

The proposed project site has been inspected along with the Deputy Conservator of Forest, Shivamogga Division, Shivamogga on dated: 13-02-2021. The details of the Fresh diversion and Re-diversion of the proposal is as below.

As discussed in the joint Inspection with Deputy Conservator of Forests, Shivamogga Division, The DCF, Shivamogga has agreed to raise a CA in single land parcel for the total extent of 4.17 Ha in the degraded forests of Shivamogga Division against the fresh diversion of 2.0833 Ha along with the CA scheme.

Further, it is submitted that the above areas come under Eco-Class-I (Moist Deciduous Forests) (OF) and Net Present Value(NPV) to be collected from the User Agency. For the same is as below:-

Sir,
I am directed to refer to your letter No.FEE 89 FGL 94 dated 16-12-1996 on the above mentioned subject, seeking prior approval of the Central Govt. in accordance with Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and to say that the proposal has been examined by the Advisory Committee constituted by the Central Government under Section 3 of the aforesaid Act

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the basis of the recommendation of the above mentioned Advisory Committee, Indian Board of Wildlife, Central Empowered Committee and the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the Central Government hereby conveys its approval under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of 449.55 hectare forest land for Upper Tunga Project, District Shimoga, Karnataka, subject to fulfilment of following conditions:-

1. Legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. Compensatory afforestation shall be raised and maintained over equivalent non-forest land by the State Forest Department.
3. The non-forest land for compensatory afforestation, shall be notified by the State Government as RF under section - 4 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or the State Forest Department within a period of 6 months and Nodal Officer (Forest Conservation) shall report the same to the State Government.
4. The State Government shall deposit all the funds including Net Present Value of diverted forest land with Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA). Till such time the CAMPA intimates the Head of Account and Planning Authority in the name of concerned Nodal Officer/DFO by the State Government.
6. Demarcation of the area will be done on ground at project cost using four feet high RCC pillars. The pillars shall indicate serial numbers, forward and back bearings and distance between adjacent pillars.

7. Trees shall not be felled upto 2 metre below FRL.
8. Trees shall be felled under the supervision of State Forest Department and only when becomes necessary.
9. Islands of the Mandegadde Bird Sanctuary shall be raised sufficiently to avoid its submergence at the project cost under supervision of Wildlife wing of State Forest Department.
10. All the safeguards and conditions stipulated by the Indian Board of Wildlife (IBWL) shall be strictly followed.
11. Reservoir so created shall be declared as 'Reserved Forest' under Indian Forest Act, 1927 and regulated fishing rights shall be allowed.
12. Water will be provided free of cost to the Forest Department for raising nursery/plantations in nearby areas.
13. No labour camps shall be established on the forest land. Labourers shall be provided fuelwood after procuring it from the State Forest Development Corporation.
14. The catchment area treatment works shall be executed as per the plan under the supervision of the State Forest Department.
15. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
16. Any other condition that the State Government or the Chief Conservator of Forests (Central), Regional Office, Bangalore may impose from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection or development of forests.



GENERAL REGULATIONS

No. G. 18205-76/2947, dated 25th May 1920

The Government of His Highness the Maharaja of Mysore are pleased to declare under the provisions of section 35 of the Mysore Forests (Amendment) Act of 1920 that the lands the limits of which are described in the schedules annexed hereto, and to be considered as public forests under the name "Kannanpara, Anandpur and Madhur Koppa Mysore" shall be the Mysore Forests under the name "Kannanpara, Anandpur and Madhur Koppa Mysore" for the purposes of the rules for the management of Mysore Forests issued with Government Notification No. 75, 22833-17, 185, 2455, dated the 14th April 1920.

Boundaries

North—Starting from the north-west corner of Survey No. 4 of Kankapur, the line runs slightly south-east through Survey No. 10 of Tanodi for 31 gauger's chains to the north-west corner of Survey No. 60 of the inner village, thence Survey Nos. 60, 59, 58, 57, 56, 55, 54, 53, 52 and 51 to the northernmost corner of Survey No. 4 of Shadgar.

East—Thence the line runs south-east along the common boundary between Shadgar and Tanodi for 23 chains to a bend thereon thence in the same direction through Survey No. 4 of the former village for 25 chains to a point 11 chains north-west from the north-east corner of Survey No. 2, thence north-west through the said Survey No. 4 for 27 chains to the north-west corner of Survey No. 20; thence Survey Nos. 20, 30, 1, 2, 3 to the north-east corner of the last survey number, thence slightly south-east along the common boundary between Survey Nos. 3 and 4 of Shadgar for 12 chains, then south-west through Survey No. 4 for 40 chains to the north-west corner of Survey No. 6; then west across Kankapurhalla for a chain to the north-east corner of Survey No. 128 of Shidgar, thence south-east and south-west and south-east along Kudaregundhalla to a point on its left bank 2 1/2 chains south-west from the easternmost corner of Survey No. 150; thence east along the left bank to a point on its right bank where a stream joins it, thence south-east through Survey No. 5 of Shadgar along the stream for 44 chains, thence in the same direction through the said survey number for 15 chains to a point on the common boundary between Shadgar and Kankapurhalla 14 chains south from the southernmost corner of Survey No. 5 of Shadgar, then south along the said common boundary for 48 chains.

North—Starting from the north-east corner of Survey No. 59 of Madhuru the line runs north-east through Survey No. 66 for 11 chains to the point on the common boundary between Madhuru and Muttinkoppa, where a jungle stream crosses it, the line then runs east along the said common boundary till it meets Mandagadde-Narasimharajapura high road.

East—Mandagadde-Narasimharajapura high road, and Survey No. 58 of Madhuru to the said high road to the south-east corner of Survey No. 65 of the said village.

South—Mandagadde State Forest demarcation line.

West—Survey Nos. 11, 14, 18, 12 of Madhuru to the south-east corner of the survey number, then south-east through Survey No. 23 for 14 chains to the western corner of Survey No. 16, thereafter Survey Nos. 15, 20, 18 Major Virapakshapur survey number, thence north-west through Survey No. 56 for 15 chains to the south-east corner of Survey No. 67; thereafter Survey Nos. 67, 66, 65 Major Tuppur site and Survey No. 59.

The Government of His Highness the Maharaja of Mysore are pleased to declare under the provisions of Section 86 of the Mysore Forest Regulation, (XI of 1900) that the lands the limits of which are described in the schedule annexed hereto, shall be constituted Minor Forests under the names of Mudagan, Alhall, Balakoppa Kodal, Varkal Minor Forests in the Narasimharajapuram Sub-Division for the purposes of the rules for the management of Minor Forests issued with Government Notification No. A. 12853-83—Pt. 185-24-S dated the 11th April 1929.
