3	<p>The KML uploaded under column C of Part-I online required correction/justification on the following points: -</p> <p>i. A fresh KML of the instant proposal needs to be provided in the polygon form of the diversion area as the proposed area for diversion is 4.9 ha, while the calculated area is 5.38 ha.</p> <p>ii. DGPS map need to be revised because from one side i.e., 31 35 52.83 77 21 59.04 not match the uploaded KML.</p> <p>iii. The KML proposed is passing through some establishment structures (Houses). State Govt needs to clarify whether the extant proposal requires displacement of the people, if yes. The same is required to be provided.</p> <p>iv. State Govt. needs to justify the extension of alignment beyond the benefits "<i>salanu</i>" in the well-forested area as it does not serve the purpose.</p> <p>v. The KML file of the project site uploaded doesn't have clear demarcation for forest/ non-forest areas. Hence, the KML file clearly indicates Forest/ Non-forest areas need to be uploaded</p>	<p>i. 11	UA shall submit an Undertaking duly authenticated by the concerned DFO that the recharge point of the seasonal streams and springs shall be taken due care from the disturbance, and sufficient measures shall be adopted to preserve the sources of these natural springs/streams and their flow.	In this regard, the User Agency has reported that no Stream, Nallah, or any other water body is falling in the alignment of the proposed road. An undertaking in this regard has been uploaded at Sr. No. 24 of additional information of Part-I.
12	The recommendation of the concerned DFO needs to be uploaded complete as per Handbook Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Forest Conservation Rules, 2003 (Guidelines & Clarifications) issued on 28.03.2019.	In this regard, DFO Seraj has submitted that the proposal has been examined in detail as per the provisions of the forest (conservation) Act, 1980 Forest conservation Rules 2003 and Guideline & clarification issued on 28.03.2019. The proposed forest land measuring 4.9 ha. falls in Seraj Forest Division under Pokhardhar & Salhanu (DPF) Protected Forest in which trees enumeration has been carried out and details have been uploaded on the Parivesh 1.0 portal. Instead of proposed diverted land Compensatory Afforestation has been proposed over 9.8 ha. of 30 Jalora forest in Sojha Beat, Banjar Block, Banjar Range, which is found suitable. The proposal is recommended from forestry point of view, subject to compliance of all conditions laid down under the forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and rules made there under.

13	<p>According to Google Earth's latest image data dated 06/2022, it seems that approx. 9.53 (ha.) is available for the new plantation/target plantation out of 9.8 (ha.). The vacant area was evaluated after excluding mature/medium-sized trees standing inside the proposed CA site visible through the latest Google Earth Image. As such, the State Govt. shall explore the possible suitable CA site approx. 0.27 (ha.) to fulfil the target plantation/new plantation i.e., 9.8 (ha.)</p>	<p>Hence, the proposal is recommended for further consideration.</p> <p>In this regard, DFO Seraj has submitted that the CA site has now been revised, and the revised digital map and topo-sheet of the CA site have been uploaded online in Part-II.</p>
