

while as per muck disposal plan of UA it is 06 in nos over an area of 1.99 ha. Difference to be clarified. As per DSS analysis the KML of the proposal is 9.31 ha which is significantly larger

than the proposed 7.34 ha. There is mismatch between the KML file and toposheet. Muck points shown in the KML are not in feature form to enable analysis of area. KML and toposheet to be corrected and submitted.

1.91 ha of additional vacant area is required to fulfill the target CA plantation.
