Sir,

With reference to the subject and letters cited above the following comments are furnished below with regards to the presence of wildlife and elephant and need for wildlife conservation plan in the proposed area for diversion.

- The proposed site falls within Rengma R.F. under Golaghat Forest Division, Golaghat District. The Reserve Forest was a prime elephant habitat in the past. The elephants of Kaziranga-Karbi Anglong landscape used to range through the said RF area in to the elephant habitat of the State of Nagaland. But due to massive encroachment and linear development, which has taken place over a period of more than 3 decades, have fragmented the habitat resulting in complete loss of traditional connectivity. Now the movement of elephants in that region is limited to Kaziranga-Karbi Anglong ER and Dhansiri-Lungding ER including PAs like- Nambor, Nambor-Doigrung and Garampani WLS. In the process HEC has increased in Golaghat and Karbi Anglong districts significantly.
- Other wild animals found in Rengma RF are - Lopard, Monitor Lizard, Fishing Cat, Slow Loris and a varieties of Reptiles and Avifauna. The animals have been at stress due to increased anthropogenic activities in and around the RF.
- The proposed diversion and establishment of Oil Well including drilling activities inside the R.F. will certainly impact the wildlife additionally.
- The above narrated facts warrant more scientific management intervention in terms of conservation and protection of wildlife.
- Considering the above facts it is suggested to deposit 1% of the Project Cost as Corpus Fund at the disposal of the CWLW, Assam for Conservation & Protection of wildlife including mitigation of Human Animal Conflict in the area as a special case, by the User Agency.
- Further, minimal disturbance shall be caused to the wild animals and their habitat by the User Agency.

This is for favour of information and necessary action.
