





With the content of above noted subject and proposal IRTD Jammu has raised EDs that the stretch of 6.00 km road of proposed road is not plausible in absence of written approval of 6.00 km of road.

Now as per EDs and DPR we have reduced the length of the proposed from 6.00 km to 5.00 km (in the KML file) as a result of which the Forest area has been reduced from 2.5453 hac to 1.505 hac. We are trying to make an amendment /recast in Form-A Part-I in the Parivesh Portal with report of the Forest area but not able to modify the same as the edit option is not working.

It is as such requested to your goodself kindly allow to make necessary amendment for the same in Form-A Part-I of Parivesh Portal.

Early & favourable action is solicited please.
