महाशय,

उपर्युक्त विषयक प्रासंगिक पत्र के सन्दर्भ में सूचित करना है कि विषयक परियोजना मेसर्स सी०सी०एल० द्वारा मगध ओ०सी०पी० फेज-2 हेतु 192.36 हे० (वन भूमि-57.29 हे० एवं जंगल झाड़ी-135.07 हे0) वन भूमि अपयोजन प्रस्ताव पर भारत सरकार, पर्यावरण वन एवं जलवायु परिवर्तन मंत्रालय, न्यू दिल्ली द्वारा 14 बिन्दुओं पर पृच्छा की गई थी। इसका निराकरण प्रतिवेदन इस कार्यालय के पत्रांक 408 दिनांक 19.07.2023 द्वारा आपको समर्पित किया गया है जिसपर प्रधान मुख्य वन संरक्षक-सह-कार्यकारी निदेशक, बंजर भूमि विकास बोर्ड, झारखण्ड, रांची के पत्रांक 848 दिनांक 17.08.2023 द्वारा समर्पित प्रतिवेदन के बिन्दु संख्या—8, 10, 11 एवं 13 पर पृच्छा करते हुए निराकरण प्रतिवेदन की मांग की गई है।

वन प्रमंडल पदाधिकारी, चतरा दक्षिणी वन प्रमंडल ने अपने पत्रांक 2226 दिनांक 11.09.2023 (छाया प्रति संलग्न) द्वारा प्रयोक्ता अभिकरण के पत्रांक PO(M)/E&F/ Compliance/2023-24 /1586 दिनांक 09.09.2023 से प्राप्त संशोधित अनुपालन प्रतिवेदन मंतव्य के साथ समर्पित किया गया है।

2	The justification for transferring the forest area from Magadh OCP to Sanghmitra OCP along with the details of approval obtained for the same shall be submitted.	96.72 Ha of forest land in respect of Magadh OCP was diverted vide F.No.8-38/2008-FC dated 18.10.2012 in favour of M/S Central Coalfields Limited (CCL). Initially Magadh OCP had a total area of 643.19 Ha in Chatra Dist. In order to achieve operational efficacy, it was decided to operate another mine named Sanghmitra. For this 147.27 Ha of Magadh OCP was transferred to proposed Sanghmitra & 495.92 Ha remains with Magadh OCP. Out of previously released 96.72 Ha forest, 83.68 Ha lies within boundary of Magadh OCP and 13.04 Ha was transferred to Sanghmitra OCP. Both Magadh OCP & Sanghmitra OCP are under administrative control of GM MS Area, CCL which is part of the User agency i.e Central Coalfields limited (CCL) and as such there is no change in user agency. In this regard a certificate of GM MS Area is attaches as Annexure III	The user agency has stated that In order to achieve operational efficacy, the forest land 13.04 Ha out of 96.72 Ha has been transferred to Sanghmitra OCP. In this regard a certificate of GM MS Area is attached as Annexure III

Total forest land Magadh OCP (Chatra Part) is (69.75 + 206.29)= 276.04 Ha

Already diverted Forest land in Magadh OCP (Chatra Part) is (96.72–13.04) = 83.68 Ha

Area of Forest Land in instant proposal is (276.04 - 83.68) = 192.36 Ha And the component wise breakup mentioned at FORM A of Magadh east OCP (192.36 Ha) is for 412.24 Ha (excluding the already diverted forest land of 83.68 Ha) as detailed below:

As such it is to submit that the land use mentioned in present application is in conformity with the approved mine plan.

The total mine lease area in respect of Magadh Project as per approved mine plan dated 10.03.2021 is 1593.73 Ha which includes the land of both Chatra (Magadh East) and Latehar District (Magadh west).

The details of notified forest and revenue forest in Latehar district is not explicitly clear due to the publication of revisional survey of land records in the year 2005. The difference in land records in Cadastral survey and revisional survey led to discrepancy in preparation of land schedule of Latehar part. The matter was taking ample time to get resolved and Magadh, being a mega mine of Central coalfields Limited, after internal discussion and consultation with State Forest officials it was decided to submit application of Chatra part separately.

As such, to expedite the clearance and avoid delay due to difference in land records of CS and RS khatiyan in Latehar District, a separate application for Chatra district (Magadh East OCP- 192.36 Ha Forest Land) was submitted vide FP/JH/MIN/87235/2020 dated 19.03.2021.

Steps are being taken to resolve the matter in Latehar district in consultation with the concerned Forest Dept. officials and State Govt. officials of Revenue dept. On resolution, the FC application of Latehar part will be submitted at the earliest.

Sanghamitra is a new mine planned in the northern side of Magadh East OCP for which proposal for forest application is under preparation.

KML of approved mine plan (1593.75 Ha) is enclosed as Annexure-IV.

The user agency Submitted that, the details of notified forest and revenue forest in Latehar district is not explicitly clear due to the publication of revisional survey of land records in the year 2005. The difference in land records in Cadastral survey and revisional survey led to discrepancy in preparation of land schedule of Latehar part. The matter was taking ample time to get resolved and Magadh, being a mega mine of Central coalfields Limited, after internal discussion and consultation with State Forest officials it was decided to submit application of Chatra part separately.

It has been observed that the user agency applying diversion of forest land within 1593.73 ha mining lease area in piecemeal. The complete KML file of the project area i.e. 1593.73 ha along with the status of approval and present landuse of forest land in the Sanghamitra OCP shall therefore submitted. A justification for submitting part proposals shall also be provided.
