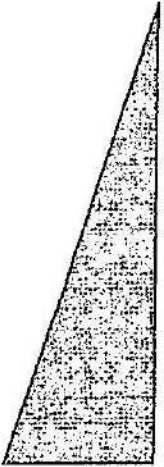

Machine operator has done this and Machine owner has submitted letter to Forest offices regarding this and they have paid Fine amount imposed by Forest office of Rs. 25000/- on dated 05/02/2019 in Forest office.</p> <p>As soon as the Forest department officials intimated us to stop the work and apply for permission through Parivesh Portal, we stopped the work. This indicates that there was no willing violation of any instruction at any point in time.</p> <p>It is humbly submitted that undersigned was neither responsible nor involved in tree felling at all. WHEREAS, the Tamhini Wildlife Sanctuary is located in the Pune and Raigad Districts of Maharashtra and is spread over an area of 49.62 square kilometers;

AND WHEREAS, the Tamhini Wildlife Sanctuary is notified vide notification of the State Government of Maharashtra number WLP. 2012/C.R.325/ F-1 dated the 03rd May, 2013;



Department/ Agencies like Forest, PWD, Municipal/Panchayat authorities, Irrigation, Electricity Board etc. and No RoW charges will be levied in the rural area of the state by the Department/ Agencies of the State Govt.

Before starting the work in Mulshi Block, we have submitted intimation letter with GR & Forest letter to Forest office Paud on dated 21/11/2016 and DCF office pune on dated 02/01/2017 but actual work order given on 21/04/2018 and vendor started work in the month Oct 2018 during this about 2 year period of intimation to forest office & period of actual work, we have not received any intimation regarding Forest area anywhere in Mulshi Block including Com. No. 133pt. at Mauje Bhamurde.

We have given Work order to vendor for laying of underground OFC cable in Mulshi Block at a depth of maximum 1.65 Mtr & width of 0.6 Mtrs, nowhere mentioned regarding any tree felling of any type at any places.

As per Notice received dated 02/04/2024 regarding the Felling of 28 trees cases, we are unaware of this case. Machine operator has done this and Machine owner has submitted letter to Forest offices regarding this and they have paid Fine amount imposed by Forest office of Rs. 25000/- on dated 05/02/2019 in Forest office. As per Machine Operator/Owner, during the work there are not any sign board seen anywhere in Forest and not any intimation received to Machine operator/owner or vendor or undersigned during work in that area. They or

undersigned also did not receive any contrary intimation during work in that area till end of 2018 to stop the work. The case is pending in the court.

As soon as the Forest department officials intimated us to stop the work and apply for permission through Parivesh Portal, we stopped the work. This indicates that there was no willing violation of any instruction at any point in time.

It is humbly submitted that undersigned was neither responsible nor involved in tree felling at all. No offence was committed knowingly, however it is assured that closer supervision shall be kept in such matters in future. - दयावी. ही जागा शक्यतो ग्रामपंचायत कार्यालयात किंवा कार्यालयाच्या नजीक असावी. तसेच ग्रामपंचायत कार्यालयात केबल जोडणीसाठी युपीएससाठी वीज पुरवठा उपलब्ध करून दयावा. यासाठी जागाभाडे / वीज पुरवठा शुल्क BBNL कडून देण्यात येईल.
४. या प्रकल्पा संबंधित कर्मचारी व प्रतिनिधीना संबंधित पंचायती राज संस्थांच्या क्षेत्रात / कार्यालयात प्रवेश देण्यात यावा.
५. ही योजना राष्ट्रीय विकास योजना आहे तसेच यातून राष्ट्रीय संपत्तीचे निर्माण होऊन सर्व ग्रामीण जनतेला हितकारक असल्याने सर्व ग्रामस्थ व अधिकारी, कर्मचारी व पदाधिकार्यांनी सामंजस्य व सहकार्याची भूमिका ठेवावी.
६. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Made on this 12th day of April, 2013 among

Department of Telecommunications, Government of India (hereinafter referred to as "Central Government") under the administrative control of Ministry of Communications & Information Technology having its office at Room no. 319, Sanchar Bhawan, Ashoka Road, Delhi - 110117 (hereinafter referred to as "DoT" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof include its administrators, successors and assigns) of the First Part,

AND

Bharat Broadband Network Limited, a company incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956 and having its registered office at Sanchar Bhawan, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as "BBNL" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and assigns) of the Second Part

AND

Government of Maharashtra (hereinafter referred to as "State Government") which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof includes its successors and assigns) of the Third Part.

WHEREAS the Central Government has proposed to establish an Optical Fiber based network for Broadband connectivity to Panchayats for Universal Services to rural population of the country and accordingly cabinet has approved vide cabinet memo no. 37/CM/2011(i) dated 28.10.2011 for creation of National Optical Fiber Network (hereinafter referred to as "NOFN") as a National Asset, for providing Broadband to Panchayats. The objective is to extend the existing optical fiber network to Panchayats by utilizing the Universal Services Obligation Fund (USOF) and creating an institutional mechanism for management and operation of NOFN for non-discriminatory access to all service providers. WHEREAS the

DOT intends to undertake the execution of the NOFN project (hereinafter referred to as the "Project") through creation of an SPV, the BBNL, on the terms & conditions contained in this agreement and Guideline for NOFN issued by Department of Telecommunications from time to time.

AND WHEREAS BBNL, the Execution Agency of the project will facilitate dissemination of information by Central/ State government for overall development of the state through creating and/ or upgrading the telecommunication/ information infrastructure in Gram Panchayat.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND AMONGST THE PARTIES HERETO as follows -

- 1.0 The Tripartite Agreement is signed between Government of India, Bharat Broadband Network Limited and Government of Maharashtra for the implementation of project in letter and spirit.
- 2.0 The Central Government has approved the formation of Executing Agency vide cabinet approval no. 37/CM/2011(i) dated 28.10.2011 and vide letter no.4/4/2009-Policy-I(pt.) dated 16.11.2011 of Department of Telecommunications for implementation, operation and maintenance of the Project under administrative control of the Department of Telecommunications (DoT). BBNL has been formed and designated as Executing Agency.

3.0 Objectives of Project

The scope of work in project includes

- a) connecting the gram panchayats of India on Optical fiber using the fiber(s) of other PSUs/TSPs and/or laying incremental fiber network for providing the broadband connectivity.
- b) setting up of suitable telecom network on this national optical fiber network for enabling of various types of applications in the gram panchayats / villages.
- c) operation and maintenance of this project in accordance with the Central Government /DoT guidelines:

Responsibilities of parties towards Installation, Operation and Maintenance of the Project

4.0 CENTRAL GOVERNMENT

- 4.1 Central Government has formed a CPSU, BBNL, under the administrative control of Department of Telecommunications, Ministry of Communications and Information Technology as executing agency.
- 4.2 The Central Government shall issue the guidelines and modalities of formulating/ implementing projects under the programme from time to time
- 4.3 The Central Government will finance the project through USO Fund.
- 4.4 The Central Government through DoT/ High Level Committee shall monitor and review the implementation of the Scheme and BBNL will execute, monitor the

implementation and provide connectivity to State Govt. : Telecom service providers to roll out different types of telecom services.

4.5 The Central Government shall approve the guidelines for operationalisation of various components of the scheme including mechanism for payment of fees to Execution Agency

5.0 BBNL, the execution agency

5.1 BBNL will provide the connectivity / Bandwidth on OFC media by tapping at suitable point of existing OFC of BSNL/ Railtel / PGCIL or by laying OFC.

5.2 BBNL will undertake all works related to laying of new Optical Fiber to reach Gram Panchayat. The work of reinstatement will be done in such a manner that best of the efforts should be made to bring the original position of the dug surfaces along the road side. Maximum efforts should be made to avoid the road cutting. HDD or Horizontal boring methods will be explored to cross the pacca road, if crossing is necessary, to minimize the damage of the road

5.3 BBNL will coordinate with State Government for all activities related to Right of Way.

5.4 BBNL can further provide OFC based connectivity to any Telecom service Provider / Internet Service Provider/ any information based service provider in the rural area

5.5 BBNL will bear the cost of space rented in Gram Panchayat Bhawan or any other location and also power consumed for the said purpose.

6.0 Union Territory/ State Government :

State Government/UT will act as a facilitator for providing NOFN services and will ensure the following

6.1 Designate a nodal department to coordinate with BBNL for implementation of NOFN Project in the State/Union Territory.

6.2 No RoW Charges including reinstatement charges will be levied by any State Government, their local bodies, companies or agencies as the information highway proposed to be created through National Optical Fiber Network for broadband connectivity to Panchayats is primarily for the benefit of the local communities to Panchayats and State Governments. This support will be considered as contribution of the State Government towards this project as a larger good for ensuring the time bound implementation of the programme and to avoid any delays in grant of RoW permission

6.3 The State Government through its competent authority will issue blanket approval to BBNL authorizing it for laying OFC without further need of RoW permission under the State agencies & electric utilities in the State for the NOFN Project during installation as well as operation and maintenance phase i.e. life cycle of the project.

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6.4 The blanket approval for RoW should be applicable to the all State Government agencies like PWD/ RES/ Forest / Municipality/ Panchayat authorities / Electricity Boards / Irrigation / Private Electricity Distribution Agency etc. as applicable.

(* subject to adherence to provisions of Forest Conservation Act wherever applicable)

6.5 State Government, will provide space and power at Gram Panchayat Bhawan or any other suitable location on cost basis for equipment placement and smooth operation of the NOFN project as required.

6.6 State Government, will provide unhindered access to BBNL's staff or its representative in Panchayat Bhawan or any other suitable location for operation/maintenance.

6.7 This agreement will be valid for operation and maintenance of the OFC Network

7.0 Advantage to State Government

7.1 Panchayats are the constitutionally mandated 3rd tier of government and key institutions for local self government in the rural areas. Coverage of Panchayats with Broadband internet connectivity has a great potential for empowering rural masses by giving them access to information, public services including those of education, health and financial inclusion.

7.2 Bandwidth requirement for Panchayats will be higher due to sharing of connectivity and extensive use of audio / video applications

7.3 The network can be used for service delivery platform for payment, enrollment and registration for targeting benefits to BPL category, MNRREGA, PDS, certificates for birth/ death/ income, land records and registration effectively and efficiently by electronic means.

7.4 State government can develop e-office for delivery of document management system, collaborative messaging, e-file, record management, project and task management, RTI, Parliament Questions, court cases, public grievances, inventory and stores, administration, Human resource, budget monitoring, circulars, events, notices, etc taking into consideration of Panchayats and rural citizen.

7.5 Other applications for the Panchayats are Government schemes, Planning, Management, Monitoring, Payments, Education, Health, Employment, Agriculture and Commerce.

7.6 Further with the help of central government standardized ICT Systems & Services state government can get robust & reliable National Network, improved efficiency & reduced costs, improved Centre-State co-ordination, improved co-ordination among states, sharing of best practices, better planning, visibility & monitoring of development, enhanced Cyber Security & Data Control, improved public service & delivery at Panchayats and improved productivity, efficiency & reduced cost.

8.0 Benefit to Panchayats.

8.1 Citizens resident in Panchayats will get easy and convenient access to public services on education, health, security, employment, agriculture, banking, pension, transport, energy, legal, etc.

8.2 They will get access to and awareness of government schemes in a transparent manner and with transactions in real time, improved Government interface and enhanced Government experience leading to citizen's empowerment.

9.0 Benefits to Government of India

- 9.1 Central Government will get standardized, secure, scalable, future proof & reliable National ICT Network & Systems, Re-engineered processes based on leading best practices, Robust & Reliable common National ICT infrastructure.
- 9.2 Central Government will be able to ensure efficient delivery of centrally sponsored schemes, enhanced access, transparency and accountability at Central & State information repository on people, places and programmes for improved planning, monitoring and implementation of Central Schemes and enhanced means for planning process at all levels.

No failure or omission to carry out or observe or perform any of the terms and conditions of this MOU shall give rise to any claim against such party or be deemed a breach of the MOU if such failure or omission arises from an act of God, act of or by Government, War or Military operation, accidents, national or local emergency, fire, lightning, explosion, flood, inclement weather, equipment failure or any other cause whatsoever similar or dissimilar outside such Party's control.

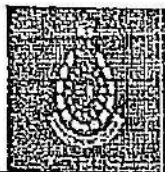

WHEREAS, the Tamhini Wildlife Sanctuary is located in the Pune and Raigad Districts of Maharashtra and is spread over an area of 49.62 square kilometers;

AND WHEREAS, the Tamhini Wildlife Sanctuary is notified vide notification of the State Government of Maharashtra number WLP. 2012/C.R.325/ F-1 dated the 03rd May, 2013;



With respect to above subject and ref. no., As per GR & Forest letter No. Room-17/Nodal/17-4/413/14-15 Dated 12/06/2014 (Enclosed herewith), we have blanket approval of Row to be applicable to all State Govt. Department/ Agencies like Forest, PWD, Municipal/Panchayat authorities, Irrigation, Electricity Board etc. and No RoW charges will be levied in the rural area of the state by the Department/ Agencies of the State Govt.

Before starting the work in Mulshi Block, we have submitted intimation letter with GR & Forest letter to Forest office Paud on dated 21/11/2016 and DCF office pune on dated 02/01/2017 but actual work order given on 21/04/2018 and vendor started work in the month Oct 2018 during this about 2 year period of intimation to forest office & period of actual work, we have not received any intimation regarding Forest area anywhere in Mulshi Block including Com. No. 133pt. at Mauje Bhamurde.

We have given Work order to vendor for laying of underground OFC cable in Mulshi Block at a depth of maximum 1.65 Mtr & width of 0.6 Mtrs, nowhere mentioned regarding any tree felling of any type at any places.

As per Notice received dated 02/04/2024 regarding the Felling of 28 trees cases, we are unaware of this case. Machine operator has done this and Machine owner has submitted letter to Forest offices regarding this and they have paid Fine amount imposed by Forest office of Rs. 25000/- on dated 05/02/2019 in Forest office. As per Machine Operator/Owner, during the work there are not any sign board seen anywhere in Forest and not any intimation received to Machine operator/owner or vendor or undersigned during work in that area. They or

undersigned also did not receive any contrary intimation during work in that area till end of 2018 to stop the work. The case is pending in the court.

As soon as the Forest department officials intimated us to stop the work and apply for permission through Parivesh Portal, we stopped the work. This indicates that there was no willing violation of any instruction at any point in time.

It is humbly submitted that undersigned was neither responsible nor involved in tree felling at all. No offence was committed knowingly, however it is assured that closer supervision shall be kept in such matters in future. It is sincerely requested to condone the un-intended felling during cable laying & drop the proposed action. Shall be grateful for your indulgence.



केंद्रशासनाने नॅशनल ऑप्टिकल फायबर नेटवर्क (NOFN) या योजनेद्वारे देशातील जवळजवळ २,५०,००० ग्रामपंचायतींना ऑप्टिकल फायबर नेटवर्कद्वारे ब्रॉडबँड इंटरनेट कनेक्शन उपलब्ध करून देण्याचा महत्वाकांक्षी प्रकल्प हाती घेतला आहे. यासाठी केंद्रशासनाने भारत ब्रॉडबँड नेटवर्क लि. (BBNL) ही कंपनी स्थापन केलेली आहे. या योजनेसाठी Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) मधून निधी उपलब्ध करण्यात आलेला आहे. नॅशनल ऑप्टिकल फायबर नेटवर्क ही राष्ट्रीय संपत्ती म्हणून निर्माण करण्यात येत आहे. राज्यातील ग्रामपंचायत स्तरापर्यंत उच्च क्षमता व उच्च दर्जाची ब्रॉडबँड इंटरनेट कनेक्टिव्हिटी (Dedicated Bandwidth सह) उपलब्ध करून देण्यात येत आहे. राज्यात या योजनेची अंमलबजावणी करण्यासाठी केंद्रशासन, राज्यशासन व BBNL या तिघांमध्ये दि. १२ एप्रिल २०१३ रोजी त्रिपक्षीय सामंजस्य करारनामा (Tripartite Memorandum of Understanding) करण्यात आलेला आहे. या योजनेमुळे राज्यात ग्रामपंचायत स्तरापर्यंत ऑप्टिकल फायबर नेटवर्कद्वारे Dedicated Bandwidth सह इंटरनेट ब्रॉडबँड कनेक्टिव्हिटी मिळाल्यामुळे ई-गव्हर्नन्स / ई-पंचायत (संग्राम) प्रकल्पाच्या अंमलबजावणीस गतिमानता येणार आहे. तसेच ग्रामीण नागरिकांनाही विविध सेवा व सुविधा कमी श्रमात व कमी वेळात त्यांचे रहिवासी क्षेत्रात उपलब्ध करून देता येणे शक्य होणार आहे. राज्यात या प्रकल्पाची अंमलबजावणी टप्प्या टप्प्याने सुरू झालेली आहे. ही योजना राष्ट्रीय विकास योजना असल्याने राज्यातील पंचायती राज संस्थांच्या हितारस्तव असल्याने महाराष्ट्र ग्रामपंचायत अधिनियम १९५८ च्या कलम १५३ (क) (पंचायतींना अनुदेश आणि निदेश देण्याचा राज्यशासनाचा अधिकार) व महाराष्ट्र जिल्हा परिषद पंचायत समिती अधिनियम १९६१ चे कलम २६ (१) राष्ट्रीय व राज्य विकास योजनांच्या हिताच्या दृष्टीने निदेश देण्याचे राज्यशासनाचे अधिकार यानुसार राज्यशासनास मिळालेल्या

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Made on this 12th day of April, 2013 among

Department of Telecommunications, Government of India (hereinafter referred to as "Central Government") under the administrative control of Ministry of Communications & Information Technology having its office at Room no. 319, Sanchar Bhawan, Ashoka Road, Delhi - 110117 (hereinafter referred to as "DoT" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof include its administrators, successors and assigns) of the First Part,

AND

Bharat Broadband Network Limited, a company incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956 and having its registered office at Sanchar Bhawan, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as "BBNL" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and assigns) of the Second Part

AND

Government of Maharashtra (hereinafter referred to as "State Government") which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof includes its successors and assigns) of the Third Part.

WHEREAS the Central Government has proposed to establish an Optical Fiber based network for Broadband connectivity to Panchayats for Universal Services to rural population of the country and accordingly cabinet has approved vide cabinet memo no. 37/CM/2011(i) dated 28.10.2011 for creation of National Optical Fiber Network (hereinafter referred to as "NOFN") as a National Asset, for providing Broadband to Panchayats. The objective is to extend the existing optical fiber network to Panchayats by utilizing the Universal Services Obligation Fund (USOF) and creating an institutional mechanism for management and operation of NOFN for non-discriminatory access to all service providers WHEREAS the

DOT intends to undertake the execution of the NOFN project (hereinafter referred to as the "Project") through creation of an SPV, the BBNL, on the terms & conditions contained in this agreement and Guideline for NOFN issued by Department of Telecommunications from time to time.

AND WHEREAS BBNL, the Execution Agency of the project will facilitate dissemination of information by Central/ State government for overall development of the state through creating and/ or upgrading the telecommunication/ information infrastructure in Gram Panchayat.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND AMONGST THE PARTIES HERETO as follows:-

1.0 The Tripartite Agreement is signed between Government of India, Bharat Broadband Network Limited and Government of Maharashtra for the implementation of project in letter and spirit.

2.0 The Central Government has approved the formation of Executing Agency vide cabinet approval no. 37/CM/2011(i) dated 28.10.2011 and vide letter no.4/4/2009-Policy-I(pt.) dated 16.11.2011 of Department of Telecommunications for implementation, operation and maintenance of the Project under administrative control of the Department of Telecommunications (DoT). BBNL has been formed and designated as Executing Agency.

3.0 Objectives of Project

The scope of work in project includes

- a) connecting the gram panchayats of India on Optical fiber using the fiber(s) of other PSUs/TSPs and/or laying incremental fiber network for providing the broadband connectivity.
- b) setting up of suitable telecom network on this national optical fiber network for enabling of various types of applications in the gram panchayats / villages.
- c) operation and maintenance of this project in accordance with the Central Government /DoT guidelines:

Responsibilities of parties towards Installation, Operation and Maintenance of the Project -

4.0 CENTRAL GOVERNMENT

4.1 Central Government has formed a CPSU, BBNL, under the administrative control of Department of Telecommunications, Ministry of Communications and Information Technology as executing agency.

4.2 The Central Government shall issue the guidelines and modalities of formulating/ implementing projects under the programme from time to time

4.3 The Central Government will finance the project through USO Fund.

4.4 The Central Government through DoT/ High Level Committee shall monitor and review the implementation of the Scheme and BBNL will execute, monitor the

implementation and provide connectivity to State Govt. : Telecom service providers to roll out different types of telecom services.

4.5 The Central Government shall approve the guidelines for operationalisation of various components of the scheme including mechanism for payment of fees to Execution Agency

5.0 BBNL, the execution agency

5.1 BBNL will provide the connectivity / Bandwidth on OFC media by tapping at suitable point of existing OFC of BSNL/ Railtel / PGCIL or by laying OFC.

5.2 BBNL will undertake all works related to laying of new Optical Fiber to reach Gram Panchayat. The work of reinstatement will be done in such a manner that best of the efforts should be made to bring the original position of the dug surfaces along the road side. Maximum efforts should be made to avoid the road cutting. HDD or Horizontal boring methods will be explored to cross the pacca road, if crossing is necessary, to minimize the damage of the road

5.3 BBNL will coordinate with State Government for all activities related to Right of Way.

5.4 BBNL can further provide OFC based connectivity to any Telecom service Provider / Internet Service Provider/ any information based service provider in the rural area

5.5 BBNL will bear the cost of space rented in Gram Panchayat Bhawan or any other location and also power consumed for the said purpose

6.0 Union Territory/ State Government :

State Government/UT will act as a facilitator for providing NOFN services and will ensure the following

6.1 Designate a nodal department to coordinate with BBNL for implementation of NOFN Project in the State/Union Territory.

6.2 No RoW Charges including reinstatement charges will be levied by any State Government, their local bodies, companies or agencies as the information highway proposed to be created through National Optical Fiber Network for broadband connectivity to Panchayats is primarily for the benefit of the local communities to Panchayats and State Governments. This support will be considered as contribution of the State Government towards this project as a larger good for ensuring the time bound implementation of the programme and to avoid any delays in grant of RoW permission

6.3 The State Government through its competent authority will issue blanket approval to BBNL authorizing it for laying OFC without further need of RoW permission under the State agencies & electric utilities in the State for the NOFN Project during installation as well as operation and maintenance phase i.e. life cycle of the project.

- 6.4 The blanket approval for RoW should be applicable to the all State Government agencies like PWD/ RES/ Forest / Municipality/ Panchayat authorities / Electricity Boards / Irrigation / Private Electricity Distribution Agency etc. as applicable.
(* subject to adherence to provisions of Forest Conservation Act wherever applicable)
- 6.5 State Government, will provide space and power at Gram Panchayat Bhawan or any other suitable location on cost basis for equipment placement and smooth operation of the NOFN project as required.
- 6.6 State Government, will provide unhindered access to BBNL's staff or its representative in Panchayat Bhawan or any other suitable location for operation/maintenance.
- 6.7 This agreement will be valid for operation and maintenance of the OFC Network

7.0 Advantage to State Government

- 7.1 Panchayats are the constitutionally mandated 3rd tier of government and key institutions for local self government in the rural areas. Coverage of Panchayats with Broadband internet connectivity has a great potential for empowering rural masses by giving them access to information, public services including those of education, health and financial inclusion.
- 7.2 Bandwidth requirement for Panchayats will be higher due to sharing of connectivity and extensive use of audio / video applications
- 7.3 The network can be used for service delivery platform for payment, enrollment and registration for targeting benefits to BPL category, MNREGA, PDS, certificates for birth/ death/ income, land records and registration effectively and efficiently by electronic means.
- 7.4 State government can develop e-office for delivery of document management system, collaborative messaging, e-file, record management, project and task management, RTI, Parliament Questions, court cases, public grievances, inventory and stores, administration, Human resource, budget monitoring, circulars, events, notices, etc taking into consideration of Panchayats and rural citizen.
- 7.5 Other applications for the Panchayats are Government schemes, Planning, Management, Monitoring, Payments, Education, Health, Employment, Agriculture and Commerce.
- 7.6 Further with the help of central government standardized ICT Systems & Services state government can get robust & reliable National Network, improved efficiency & reduced costs, improved Centre-State co-ordination, improved co-ordination among states, sharing of best practices, better planning, visibility & monitoring of development, enhanced Cyber Security & Data Control, improved public service & delivery at Panchayats and improved productivity, efficiency & reduced cost.

8.0 Benefit to Panchayats.

- 8.1 Citizens resident in Panchayats will get easy and convenient access to public services on education, health security, employment, agriculture, banking, pension, transport, energy, legal, etc.

8.2 They will get access to and awareness on government schemes in a transparent manner and with transactions in real time, improved Government interface and enhanced Governance experience leading to citizen's empowerment.

9.0 Benefits to Government of India

9.1 Central Government will get standardized, secure, scalable, future proof & reliable National ICT Network & Systems, Re-engineered processes based on leading best practices, Robust & Reliable common National ICT Infrastructure.

9.2 Central Government will be able to ensure efficient delivery of centrally sponsored schemes, enhanced access, transparency and accountability at Central & State information repository on people, places and programmes for improved planning, monitoring and implementation of Central Schemes and enhanced inputs for planning process at all levels.

9.3 Better Centre-State interface for information sharing and collaboration will improve public trust in the Government system as a whole and improved productivity, efficiency & reduced cost of the central schemes for welfare of citizen.

10.0 Confidentiality

All parties shall preserve the confidentiality of the information, which may be exchanged between the parties from time to time as being essential to this MOU and agree not to disclose the same to any outside party. However, each party shall be free to disclose such information as:

- Part of the public domain at the time of disclosure or
- Required to be disclosed by official authorities in accordance with the applicable laws.

11.0 Arbitration and Applicable Law

11.1 The parties hereby agree that any controversy, claim or dispute arising out of the interpretation, application or in connection with this MOU which cannot be resolved amicably, shall be referred to the Secretary (Telecom), Govt. of India whose decision shall be final and binding on the parties. All disputes will be resolved as per the Government of India policies and applicable Indian Laws.

11.2 All three parties shall not use logos, trademarks and intellectual property of each other.

12.0 Force Majeure

No failure or omission to carry out or observe or perform any of the terms and conditions of this agreement shall give rise to any claim against such party or be deemed a breach of this MOU if such failure or omission arises from an act of God, act of or omission of Government, War or Military operation, accidents, national or local emergency, fire, lightning, explosion, flood, inclement weather, equipment failure or any other cause whatsoever similar or dissimilar outside such Party's control.

13.0 Validity: This MOU shall come into force upon signature by all three parties and shall be valid for entire duration of the project.

14.0 Termination

14.1 This MOU can be terminated under same exigency conditions by the concerned parties under mutual agreement.

14.2 In case of war/hostilities, suspended based on operational requirements towards national security can be resumed by giving three months' notice to the first party and can resume the same at the end of the war/hostilities.

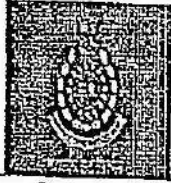

There is a reserved forest bearing Compartment No.133pt. at Village Bhamburde, Tal. Mulshi, Dist. Pune. You are the Sub Divisional Engineer (NOFN/OFC) Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited Pune and in order to lay down optical fibre cable in the reserved forest you passed an order to dig trenches and to fell trees and to lay down optical fibre cable in the trench. On the basis of your Order a Work Order was issued and the concerned Contractor dug up trench of the length of about 1 km. and also felled 28 trees along the trench.

As per Section 2 of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980. No authority shall make, except with the prior approval of the Central Government, any order directing that any forest land may be used for any non forest purpose.

You by passing an Order to use the reserved forest described above for use of laying down optical fibre cable you have passed an order to use the forest land for non forest purpose and it appears that you are guilty of contravention of the provisions of Section 2 of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980. You are hereby called upon to show cause as to why action should not be taken against you for committing such offence under that Act within fifteen days from the receipt of the Notice. If you fail to show cause as to why action should not be taken against you necessary action as per the provisions of the Act will be taken.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Government of Maharashtra's letter No. FFD-1923/C.R.229/F-10 dated 02.02.2024 on above subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section 2 (1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and to say that after examination of proposal the following shortcomings have been observed:-

- i. The Regional Office Nagpur vide letter dated 15.01.2024 had returned the proposal to the state government with a request to take action under section 3A/3B and submit the proposal directly to the MoEFCC for further consideration. In this regard, the letter received from the State Govt does not mention anything about the action taken under section 3A/3B of the Van(Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan Adhiniyam) 1980. The State Government shall therefore intimate whether the action under section 3A/3B has been initiated in the instant case or not. An action taken report in this regard shall be submitted.
- ii. The DFO concerned in his site inspection report has informed that the proposed area lies within the ESZ of the Tamhini Wildlife Sanctuary and Sudhagad Wildlife Sanctuary. The State Govt may ensure that the activity is permissible within the ESZ and submit a report to the ministry in this regard.
- iii. The DFO in Part-II of the application form has intimated that violation has been stated from the year 2018, while in the Violation report it has been indicated that violation has been started in the year 2019. The State Government may therefore inform the exact details of violation by the user agency.
- iv. State Government has uploaded Shape file/KML file over an area of 0.764 ha of forest land instead of 0.28 ha. Therefore, the State Govt. is requested to upload the correct KML file of 0.28 ha proposed forest land.
- v. The DGPS Map and Survey of India Topo-sheet Map showing the proposed

forest land for diversion uploaded on PARIVESH portal are not legible in nature. Therefore the State Govt. shall upload legible copies of maps.

In view of the above, the State Government is requested to submit the information/ documents, as indicated above for further consideration of the proposal in the Ministry.

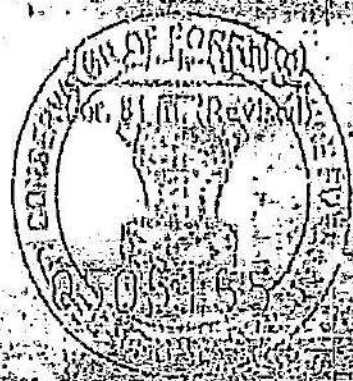
