2. DCF Rampur has submitted point wise reply to the observations raised vide above referred letter is as under: -

Sr No.	Observation	Reply
1	In response to point No.2 the EIA as asked by GoI is still not found uploaded on PARIVESH Portal.	User agency has intimated that the proposal No. FP/HP/MIN/34194/2018 for mining is linked with this proposal. The application to obtain EIA has been submitted to HPSEIAA Shimla vide online Application No. SIA/HP/MIN/31499/2019 dated 18.05.2019. The same will be granted after approval of diversion of forest land under FCA 1980 from the competent authority. Copy of letter as received from HPSEIAA has been uploaded on the PARIVESH Portal Part-I as additional information at Sr. No. 10 with the name EC letter dated 02.04.2025.
2	The reply to point No.3 the documentary proof of handing over /taken over on 10.9.2018 are not found uploaded. Further as per site inspection report it has been observed that the handed over area is not reclaimed as per the guidelines. Reasons for the same may be provided	User agency has intimated that the request letter of the patch of land proposed to be surrendered measuring an area of 0.1964 ha. out of 0.2898 ha has already been submitted to DFO Rampur on dated 10.09.2018 and the copy of the same has been uploaded as additional information at Sr. No. 11 of Part-I with the name “ Land proposed to be surrendered/handover “ The area needs to be reclaimed by user agency (site inspection report of the concerned RFO has been uploaded in Part-II as additional information at Sr No. 2) and user agency is committed to pay the reclamation amount before grant of final approval (after Stage- I approval)
