Plants @ 1000 plants per hectare will be planted. The species to be planted will be mainly conifer and other misc. species of broad leaved plants. The plantation will be raised in the following year after the approval of FCA proposal and further maintenance and beating up of failures will be done for the subsequent ten years. The scheme will be implemented by Forest Department through DFO, Doda. Total financial Outlay for compensatory plantation scheme is 2694596/- Site is suitable for Compensatory Afforestation. The monitoring will be done as per existing monitoring mechanism in the forest department at present.
