

 INTRODUCTION: Power Department, Govt. of Sikkim has proposed for diversion of 26.8 ha (16.4 ha in RF/Khasmal/river Reserve + 10.427 Ha in buffer & transition zone of KNP) of forest land for laying of 220 KV D/C Singhik-Chungthang Transmission Line under CSSTDS in Mangan District of Sikkim.

The forest land involved is **26.8** ha and the stipulation would be double the area proposed for diversion i.e **53.68** ha

The Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt. of India has prescribed the following guidelines for diversion:

- In all cases the legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- ii. User agency would have to pay the cost of Compensatory Afforestation to the State Forest Department.

3. INTEGRATED PROGRAMME / METHODOLOGY OF WORK FOR EXECUTION

I. The Seedling Requirement: The requirement of seedlings may be met from the existing nurseries of the Department on payment basis as per the approved rates. The existing nurseries will have to be provided with the seeds of mixed species including the cost of nursery implements used.

- II. Choice of species: Mixed plantation of site-specific species indigenous fruit bearing and timber able species namely, Magnolia lanuginosa, Quercus spp, Rhododendron spp, Schima wallichii, Duabanga grandiflora, Choero spondias axillaris, Exbucklandia populnae, etc.
- III. Time Scheduled: Schedule of work maybe in the Financial Year 2023-2024 subject to availability of fund in time from the User Agency.
- IV. Executing Agency: The works under the Scheme shall be executed by the of Forest and Environment Department, Government of Sikkim through East Territorial Division and Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 Cell as per the approval of the Government.
- V. Monitoring and Evaluation: all the activities under the Scheme may be monitored by a committee constituted for the purpose, Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and the representative from Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India concurrently and regularly.

On the basis of aforementioned joint certificates and examination of all other relevant records, I do hereby certify that non-forest land, revenue lands, zudpi jungle, chhotejharka jungle, bade jharka jungle, jungle-jhari land, civil-soyam lands and other such categories of forest lands (except the forest land under management and administrative control of the Forest Department) on which the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 are applicable, which as per the extant guidelines of the Central Government may be utilized for creation of compensatory afforestation in lieu of forest land diverted for non-forest purpose, are not available in the entire State of Sikkim.
