It is submitted that, the additional information/ clarification / uploading etc., as desired by the Government in the reference 3rd cited is submitted herewith. The Point-wise information is as follows.

Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer(FCA) reported that, the User Agency has identified non-forest land over an extent of 5.15 ha in Sy. no. 104, Bheemavaram (V), Anthagiri (M), for Compensatory Afforestation purpose and further reported that the Compe	The user agency has identified non-forest land to an extent of 5.15 ha towards compensatory Afforestation purpose in lieu of forest land over an extent of 3.63 ha proposed for diversion. The non-forest land areas has good existing vegetation, hence compensatory Afforestation is proposed in degraded forest land (DFL) in Chippapalli Reserve Forest over equivalent extent. Further, there are (2) road proposals from the same user agency as furnished below for which the Degraded Forest land over an extent of 10.24 ha (effective area is 8.59 ha) in lieu of forest land over an extent of

nsatory Afforestation land is covered with good vegetation and non scope for plantation and therefore proposed to raise the CA plantation in Chippapalli RF over an extent of 5.15 ha. However, in the same letter, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests reported that CA scheme to an extent of 3.63 ha with financial out lay of Rs. 39.748 lakh for a period from 2022-23 to 2033-34 with 10 years of maintenance has been proposed. Whereas, as per the documents uploaded by the Divisional Forest Officer under recommendation tab under Part-II, the Divisional Forest Officer proposed CA scheme for taking up of plantation over an extent of 5.15 ha of DFL area with financial out lay of 47.74 lakhs. In view of the above, it is requested to clarify the above discrepancies and also report actual extent of non-forest area earmarked in lieu of subject diversion proposal and actual extent of DFL under which CA is proposed to be carried out;

The Compensatory Afforestation is to be taken up for effective area of 3.63 ha of degraded forest land for Rs.39.748 lakh for the subject proposal and not 5.15 ha and the same may be rectified.

2	Upon examination of the online application, it is found that kml file of the CA area has not been uploaded in the online application by the U	Instruction are noted and documents are uploaded at designated places.
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A & DFO concerned and other documents like C A scheme, soil suitability certificate etc, have also not been uploaded under designated places by the DFO in PART-II. In view of the Ministry's guideline No.11/14/2021-FC -Part(1) dated: 22.02.2023, it is requested the concerned officials may be directed to upload all relevant documents including kml etc., in the designated places in the online application.

The Government are requested to onward submit the above information to the GoI, MoEF & CC, IRO, Vijayawada to accord clearance under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as deemed fit in the matter.
