No.	It has been reported that proposal forest land was notified as Reserved Forest vide notification dated 21.12.2017 and 10.04.2019 and as per proposal timeline the Nodal office accepted the proposal on 06.12.2019 and processed the proposal as diversion of 6.076 ha forest land (Zudpi Jungle) whereas the proposal is for diversion of 6.076 ha Reserve Forest land indeed. Therefore, the clarification behind processing the proposal as diversion of Zudpi Jungle land instead of diversion of Reserve forest land needed submission.	The proposed forest area was originally recorded as Zudpi Jungle land which is now reserved forest (notified u/s 4 of IFA 1927). While the Project Authority has executed construction of transmission line from the year 2014 to 2018 in the proposed forest land which was then recorded as Zudpi Jungle in the revenue records and the notification of said land u/s of IFA 1927 was under process. Hence, the proposal for diversion of 6.076 ha forest land was inadvertently processed as diversion of Zudpi Jungle instead of Reserved Forest. However, during processing Part-II of the proposal it was clearly mentioned that the proposed forest land (zudpi jungle) has been notified under section 4 of IFA 1927 as Reserved Forest (copy enclosed).			
II	The State Govt. has now reported that the plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal plants) shall be carried out within the RoW of transmission line. However, the approved scheme along with financial outlay and species to be planted has not been submitted.	This office submits a separate plantation scheme of medicinal plants under the RoW of transmission line along with financial outlay and species to be planted. User agency has submitted an undertaking to bear the cost of plantation of medicinal plants to be carried out within RoW under the supervision of State Forest Department. Also confirm to undertake that all such funds will be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (http://parivesh.nic.in).			
III	Copy of Wildlife Clearance for the instant proposal has not been submitted and same needs submission.	Wildlife proposal No. WL/MH/Trans/ 450298/2023 is approved by NBWL vide APCCF Wildlife Nagpur letter No. Kaksh -23(2)Waji/Survey/ No.190/2167/2024-25 dated 07/10/2024.  As per Central Government guidelines of March 2024 the approval to commence the work will be issued by Chief Wildlife Warden (CWW) only after submission of documents for In-principle approval to the proposal under FCA 1980. The copy of the wildlife clearance is attached herewith.			
IV	As per the DSS analysis, the total area of forest land and Non-forest land involved in the project is found to be 235.436 ha instead of 232.2565 ha.(226.1805 ha+6.0760 ha) reported by the State Govt. Hence, variation of 3.1795 ha in the project area has been observed which requires clarification.	As per the compliance submitted by User Agency, The non-forest areas for transmission line are used as ROU under electricity act. As the said lands are not acquired therefore the non forest areas are computed base on village maps and revenue records before arriving to non forest area to 226.1805 ha. And for forest areas field measurements are carried out with joint site inspections before arriving to forest area of 6.076 ha. The KML file
