- 2. The point wise observation raised vide above referred communication is attended as under:-
 - 1. (i) The copy of records of consultation and meetings of FRC and Sub Divisional Level committee of village Dharjol has been uploaded against the appropriate column of Part-I.
 - (ii) The copy of records of consultation and meetings of Gram Sabha concerned has been uploaded against the column No. K of Part-I.
 - 2. In this regard user agency submitted that 0.9049 ha. non forest /private land has also been included for which the copies of sale deed gift deeds/ affidavits made in favour of HPPWD has been uploaded at Sr. No. 7 against the additional information detail of Part-I.
 - 3. (i) The muck management plan and detail of measurement of muck debris to be generated in the project have been uploaded at Sr. No. 8 against the additional information detail of Part-I.
 - (ii) In Muhal Dharjol/32 and Sandoa /223, Khasra No. 493 and 322 have been donated for the dumping site by the concerned private land owner i.e. Sh. Himmat Ram Muhal Dharjol donated an area of 0.08 ha. and Sh. Yograj Sharma Muhal Sandoa has also donated an area of 0.08 ha. for dumping site. The revenue Nakal Jamabandi detail of

- the same has also been uploaded at Sr. No. 8 against the additional information detail of Part-I.
- 4. The Soil Moisture Conservation Plan has been uploaded at Sr. No. 8 against the additional information detail of Part-II.
- 5. In this regard user agency has reported that the village Dharjol is a cluster of various inhabitation situated at 0.500, 1.00, 1.500 Km far from each other. It is clear that an another link road is existing from Geo reference 31 43;27.87/76 44'39.06 which cover only on inhabitation and it leads from on carrier of village Dharjol to down ward of south direction up in the proposed road of geo-reference 31 43'2.23/76 49'.97 but this road does not attract the FCA provision because this path / road used to be very ancient, which was used for grazing cattle/mule path and for drinking water. This road is not a part of proposed road in any way.
