There was no issue of Tiger Corridor and the proposal reached up to the APCCF & Nodal Officer. It was first informed to the Project proponent while responding to the observation of Nodal Officer's Letter No. 2171, dated 22.10.2020 that the location falls under the low pinch area of Tiger Corridor as per publication of the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) "Tiger Corridor of Eastern Vidarbha" and instructed to submit proposal for the Wildlife Clearance from the State Wildlife Board and National Wildlife Board vide Letter No. 3152, dated 25/01/2021. In response, the Project proponent submitted proposal for the Wildlife Clearance at the MoEF&CC Portal PARIVESH on dated 25.08.2021, vide Proposal No. FP/MH/MIN/42236/2019. Now the Proposal for Wildlife Clearance is under process at the esteemed office of the PCCF (WL) & Chief Wildlife Warden since dated 08.08.2022.
