

Report may be submitted after verification.	Gut number wise area has been re-checked, Since gut no. 9 and 10 of village Sawali area connected and there is no demarcation of boundaries of each gut number marked on ground and found intermingled with each other. Revised gut wise area proposed for diversion has been incorporated in land statement. The details are as under Gut no. 9, Forest: 7.93 ha (Area as per 7/12 is 7.93) Gut no. 10 (P), Forest: 2.763 (Area as per 7/12 ha is 8.5 ha).
