Khaneri, Tehsil Rampur Distt. Shimla HP in favour of M/s Bushahr Laghu Udyog VPO Jhakri, Tehsil Rampur Bushahr within the jurisdiction of Rampur Forest Division, Distt. Shimla H.P. (Online Proposal No. FP/HP/MIN/34194/2018).

Kindly refer to your office letter No. 1832 dated 05/08/2025 on the subject cited above.

2. In this context, it is submitted that the point wise reply to the observation raised vide your office letter under reference is furnished as under:-

Sr.No	Observation	Reply
1	The State Government has intimated the Ministry that there is no violation in the proposed area and that the lower part of the proposed area where non forestry work is visible is part of a lease granted earlier. As per additional documents, an approval of 0.2896 Ha ha (instead of 0.5448 ha) in Rampur forest division was accorded by the Ministry on 18.07.2006. Therefore, Compliance report of Stage- II approval of earlier proposal may be submitted.	Compliance report of Stage -II approval is uploaded in Part II Sr. no. 15 in additional information.
2	As per submission of the State Government, CA land has been changed. However, a kachha road is visible as per DSS of new CA land. Comments from State Government are sought in the matter.	The CA site has not been changed. The CA site area is differently recorded in revenue and forest records. As per revenue record the proposed CA site is UF-Shandal. However, as per the working plan the same area is recorded D-113 Suki gad NDPF. The confusions has only arisen due to non-reconciliation of the forest and revenue records, otherwise the CA area has not been changed. The kachhatrack visible within CA Land is a temporary track to the water tank there. The track is minimally used. Furthermore, an alternate foottrack is also available to access water tank from Lambidhar which is outside of proposed CA land. Thus, the presence of the track will not hamper the plantation area in any way.

3	As per DSS, some parts of revised CA site is falling outside the boundary of Sukigad UPF. Comments from State Government regarding the legal status of some parts of proposed CA land which are falling outside Sukigad UPF needs to be submitted.	The Legal Status of the parts of the proposed CA land falling outside DPF Sukigad is UF- Shandal Malik -Sarkar Himachal Pradesh and Kism - Chargah Bila Drakhtan as per the Revenue records. Furthermore, as per the notification of the state government NoFt. 29-241/B/B/49 dated 25.02.1952 all such wastelands are deemed protected forests in the state of Himachal Pradesh.
4	The CA scheme and suitability certificate for revised CA site is not submitted along with the reply. Therefore, CA scheme and site suitability certificate for revised CA site needs to be submitted. In view of the above, the State Govt. is requested to submit the information.	The CA scheme need not to be revised as the land has not been changed. Site suitability certificate for revised CA site has been issued based on case record and is uploaded at Sr no....19..... additional information of Part-II
