Sir,

Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, New Delhi vide letter under reference No.1 has sought compliance on 8 points. Accordingly, the Chief Conservator of Forests (T.), Kolhapur vide letter under reference No.2 has submitted the compliance of shortcomings on 8 points to this office. The compliance report on 8 points as desired by the Government of India vide letter dated 29/12/2022 is being submitted as under:-

1	The State Govt. has not provided the basic details of the area to be vacated by relocating the village Deur. The complete details of the area under different components including habitation, agriculture, nistar rights and other land-use categories along with documentary evidence shall be submitted. 		Deur is attach here with. (ANNEXURE – A) Due to error in totaling the area in form no. 1 (Revenue record), it has been shown 2141.09 ha. instead of 2140.9 ha.
2	The correct KML file of 46.06 ha area proposed for diversion shall be uploaded on PARIVESH.	The Correct KML File of 46.06 ha. area uploaded on PARIVESH Portal.
3	The State has intimated that no plantation work has been carried out in the area proposed for diversion, whereas apart from the satellite imagery, the site inspection report submitted by the CF, Kolhapur & the DCF, Satara mentions about the mixed species plantations of 15 to 17 years old within the area selected for diversion. This needs clarification.	It is clarified that, in working plan Volume-II of Satara Forest Division (2010.11 to 2019.20) it has been mentioned that mix plantation was taken in the year 2003 on 20.00 ha. area of village Bopegaon. Records shows that no plantation activity has been taken up since 2003 in this village. Copy of related pages of working plan attached as - ANNEXURE – B.
4	High-resolution satellite imagery forest village 'Deur' shows the presence of Wind mills and a Road connecting the Wind mills. Keeping this in view, the area will not be inviolate despite the relocation of villagers. This needs justification.	Wind mills and a road connecting the wind mills seen in the High-resolution satellite imagery of village 'Deur' are outside the area of the village Deur. These structures are within the limits of village Chalakewadi which is adjacent to the village Deur. The village Chalakewadi is in the buffer of Sayhadri Tiger Reserve. Also there is large altitudinal difference in the area occupied by wind mills and majority area of village Deur. Habitants of village Deur are largely dependent on fishing & agriculture for livelihood which is causing disturbance in the area. Hence their relocation is going to make the area inviolate. Corrected KML File is attached herewith.
5	As per the satellite imagery only four settlements are visible within the forest village 'Deur'. Whereas the State has mentioned the number of PAPs as 28, which needs justification.	As per the list prepared by the revenue department 28 PAP's of village Deur are entitled for rehabilitation. The satellite imagery of village Deur shows 4 settlements. 11 PAP's along with there families stay in these 4 settlements. The remaining PAP's are migrated to the near by villages due to harsh conditions in the core areas. The PAP's have given consent for the rehabilitation and there rights are to be settled and these areas has to be acquired for making the core area inviolate.
6	As per DSS Analysis, the area of KML file submitted for forest village 'Deur' is found to be 2132.768 ha. instead of	The correct KML file of village Deur is submitted here with in CD.

	2140.19 ha as reported by the State Govt. Therefore, the correct KML file of 2140.19 ha. shall be submitted.	
7	As per DSS Analysis, the calculated area of KML file of Koyna Wildlife Sanctuary is found to be 333.054 sq.km instead of 335.30 sq. km. Therefore, the correct KML file of Koyna Wildlife Sanctuary (335.30 sq.km) shall be submitted.	The correct KML file of Koyna Wildlife sanctuary is submitted here with in CD.
8	The total number of "villagers" to be rehabilitated in the Village 'Deur' along with the number of 'families' entitled for relocation or rehabilitation under the scheme shall be submitted.	As per the PAP's list prepared by the revenue department 28 PAP's of village Deur are entitled for rehabilitation. These 28 PAP's are having 32 major person's (above 18 years age on decided date) called "Families" and total population of village is 66 as per 2011 census.
