Sub:- Proposal for diversion of 78.548 ha forestland for laying of 132 KV S/C Transmission Line from Seppa to Bameng under Comprehensive scheme for strengthening of transmission and distribution system by Power Deptt. in East Kameng District of Arunachal Pradesh.

With reference to above letters on the subject, it is to enclose herewith following information:

1	To clarify on the numbers of trees to be felled as it is mentioned as 1090 Nos. including poles in the forwarding letter whereas in the submitted enumeration list a total of 2430 Nos. has been observed ( i.e. 514 Nos. of trees and 743 Nos. of poles as estimated in Seppa to Pachi and 576 Nos. of trees and 597 Nos. of poles in Pachi to Bameng).	In the forwarding letter, 1090 Nos. of poles has been mentioned inadvertently. Therefore actual number of trees is 1090 Nos. and 1340 Nos. poles.
2	The scientific/local name of 154 Nos. and 12 Nos. of 'unknown' trees species as mentioned in the enumeration list from Seppa to Pachi and Pachi to Bameng respectively.	The local name of 'unknown' 154 Nos. and 12 Nos. of trees from Seppa to Pachi and Pachi to Bameng is ' <b>Moubi</b> '.
3	To review the compensatory afforestation estimation as proposed at Sl.No. 14 & 15 of the CA scheme for construction of OBT laborer (2-room) and Basha Type quarter as they are not eligible under CAF rules.	As per Forest (Conservation) Act'80, State Govt. has been permitted to prepare the CA estimate for 10 years. Hence the State has included items in the norms for preparation of CA estimate as per climatic & geographical conditions of the State and as per the necessity for successful implementation of scheme. The identified CA sites are far from the Range head

		quarter. Therefore considering geographical conditions of the State and difficult terrain, the construction of temporary building at the work site for 10 years is required for successful implementation of the scheme. The items like building, monitoring, supervision (POL), maintenance of vehicle etc. under NPV as per CAF Rule are meant for NPV component only. The items as included in the CA estimate are as per norms approved by the State Govt. and as per reasons as mentioned above.
4	To complete the uploading of the proposal on Parivash portal as the same is pending in DFO level.	Uploaded on Parivash portal completely
5	State Govt. comment/clarification on the proposed area as it is found to be 'INVIOLATE' due to the presence of Hydrological Layer as per the DSS report of FSI, Dehradun.	Generally the laying of transmission line is to be constructed through the forest areas avoiding human habitation as per the guidelines in extant. Moreover in case of transmission line, the tree felling is limited to the raising of towers at places, where the T/L comes in to the proximity of the trees and not all, but some of the trees only will be required to be felled. The cleared forest land is re-planted with dwarf species. Thus there will hardly be any impact on hydrological layer.
6	The mutation certification and preliminary notification for Kassing Putu (Ago) VFR and Repari (Rakhe) VFR where an area of 88.10 ha and 69.00 ha respectively has been proposed for compensatory afforestation, if any	The preliminary notification for Kassing Putu (Ago) VFR and Repari (Rakhe) VFR is enclosed as <b>Annexure-I</b> .

It is therefore, requested to kindly issue necessary formal approval for diversion of 78.548 ha forest land for laying of above transmission line under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act' 1980.
