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With reference to 1st cited, it was instructed to obtain the additional information from the Executive Engineer (R&B) NH Division. Vide ref 2nd cited, Executive Engineer (R&B) NH Division, Vijayawada has submitted additional information and is as follows :

1. As per the area statement, it reveals that the user agency proposed for widening of existing road to 24 mtrs width (excluding 7 mtrs width in one stretch and 10 mtrs in remaining stretches). However, the State Government has not reported whether the existing road is RoW as mentioned under RF Notification or constructed with prior approval of GoI, the same is excluded from the width portion within the total forest area proposed for diversion i.e., 9.33 Ha. It was decided in the REC meeting so seek clarification on this issue.

Reply : The User Agency has informed that the existing road is old Pamur – Kandukur- Singarayakonda road, was constructed before 1980 and is passing through 03 RFs i.e Botlagudur RF, Bodawada RF and Malakonda RF in Giddalur Division in Prakasam District in the state of Andhra Pradesh.

The existing road is within the RoW as mentioned under RF Notifications and the notification copies are herewith enclosed.

2. In case existing road is constructed in the RoW, supporting documents like RF Notification etc., shall be submitted.


