Reference is invited to the subject mentioned above. The above proposal was discussed in the 82<sup>nd</sup> meeting of Standing Committee of National Board for Wild Life held on 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

2. After discussions, the Standing Committee decided to recommend the proposal with the following conditions:


- I. The User Agency shall implement the Animal Passage Plan approved by the Chief Wild Life Warden prepared on the basis of WII guidelines named Eco-friendly Measures to mitigate Impacts on Linear Infrastructures on Wildlife.
- II. The User Agency shall not violate any provisions of Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.
- III. The User Agency shall not harm or destroy wildlife habitat including fauna and flora of the Sanctuary.
- IV. The User Agency shall not use the area for any other work other than the work permitted.
- V. The User Agency shall not establish any temporary or permanent labour camp in the Sanctuary.
- VI. The User Agency shall have to prepare a conservation plan relevant to the biological entity affected due to the project and deposit the fund before initiating any work on the land.



- VII. The User Agency or his contractor shall not create any fire places inside the Sanctuary.
- VIII. All the material required for the work shall be prepared outside the sanctuary.
- IX. The work in the Sanctuary shall be allowed only in the day time from 8 AM to 6 PM.
- X. Approval under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, if required, shall be obtained separately for use of forest land.
- XI. The User Agency shall deposit NPV for the use of land of Protected Area as per the existing rates before initiating any work on the land.
- XII. The User Agency shall create adequate facilities for safe transit of wildlife across the road.
- XIII. An annual compliance certificate on the stipulated conditions shall be submitted by the User Agency to the State Chief Wild Life Warden and an annual compliance certificate shall be submitted by the State Chief Wild Life Warden to Government.





A proposal was received vide reference no.1 above for diversion of 3.4202 ha from Balaram Ambaji Sanctuary for widening of existing road from Gabbar Taleti to Gabbar Circle road from km.166.520 to 166.974 and km.167.177 to 168.412 in favour of Public Works Department, District Banaskantha, Gujarat.
2. The proposal was placed before the State Board for Wildlife (SBWL) in its 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 24-08-2023 for consultation. The SBWL has approved and recommended the proposal in its meeting vide reference no. 2 above with certain conditions.
3. The said proposal was submitted to Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India, New Delhi for consideration of Standing Committee of National Board for Wildlife (SCNBWL) vide reference no.3. The proposal was discussed in 82<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Standing Committee of NBWL held on 12-03-2025. The Standing Committee of NBWL recommended the proposal vide reference no.4 with certain conditions.
4. Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, WL Division, Government of India has passed an order dated 02-05-2025 in vide reference no. 6 above. The order of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, WL Division, Government of India.
5. Therefore in view of the mentioned references, the permission is hereby granted to use of 3.4202 ha from Balaram Ambaji Sanctuary for widening of existing road from Gabbar Taleti to Gabbar Circle road from km.166.520 to 166.974 and km.167.177 to 168.412 favour of Public Works Department, District Banaskantha, Gujarat subject to following conditions:
