The necessary clarification in this regard has been uploaded online in additional information at Sr. No. 53 of Part- I.</p> <p>Since, the approved capacity of the proposed SHEP is 2.00 MW and CIA &amp; CSS study of Beas basin for projects less than 5.00MW has not been carried out, therefore , instant proposal is not a part of the same. Further, the proposal has already been recommended in Part- II and III.</p>
