Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India, Regional Office, Nagpur vide letter under reference No.1 has sought compliance on 06 points. Accordingly, the Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Thane vide letter under reference No. 2 has submitted the compliance of shortcoming in this regard to this office. The compliance report as desired by Government of India vide letter dt.30/04/2021 is submitted as under:-

DCF, Alibag has mentioned in his certificate that proposed line is not included in ESZ of Karnala Bird Sanctuary, in the same certificate he has also mentioned that distance from Karnala Bird Sanctuary is 0.84 Km. As per notification of Eco-Sensitive Zone around Karnala Wildlife Sanctuary dated 22/01/2016, Eco sensitive Zone varies from 0-8 km. Therefore as per notification, the line is within Eco-sensitive Zone of Sanctuary. Clarification Karnala Wildlife for the same and necessary approval from NBWL shall be obtained and submitted by the State Government. Comments from (Wildlife), Maharashtra on the importance of area from wildlife point of view and conservation measures, if any may also be obtained and submitted by the State Government

Complete compliance ensuring importance of Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 is not submitted along with proposal. Wherein, supporting documents in terms of consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committees(s) submitted. Original FRA-2006 certificate along with English translated copies of documentary evidences in the form of copies of the resolution of the concerned Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha (s), Sub-Divisional Level Committee(s) recording their consent for the proposal and bearing signature of the participants shall submitted.

The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag vide letter No. B/20/Land/700, dated 30/07/2021 has reply below:-

The Karnala Bird Sanctuary Eco-Sensitive Zone is finalized vide notification dated 22/01/2016. As per this notification Eco-Sensitive Zone is declared around the sanctuary is starts from 0.000 Km to 8.000 Km. In this project proposed nearest distance of line is 0.84 Km form Karnala Bird Sanctuary but at that point the ESZ boundary is less than the proposed line. The proposed line is not included in the ESZ Karnala Bird Sanctuary. In this project whole transmission line will pass outside the ESZ area of Karnala Bird Sanctuary. The Bird Sanctuary and the ESZ map is enclosed herewith in the map is clearly indicates that this proposed transmission line is outside to the ESZ of Karnala Bird Sanctuary.

In this regard, the approval of NBWL is not required for this project. The copy of the notification 22/01/2016 dated is enclosed herewith (Annexure No.V)

Government of India vide letter No.11-43/2013-FC. guidelines has issued dt.3/12/2018 compliance of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forests Right) Act, 2006. As per these guidelines:-

'Accordingly, it is clarified that within the time period stipulated for compliance of Stage I condition, Deputy Commissioner shall complete the process of compliance of FRA (including forwarding its findings to be concerned CF), hence for the purpose of the MoEF & CC, as per the provisions under the Forest (Conservation) amendment rules, 2016 the compliance under FRA is not required for consideration of in-principle approval. This has to be furnished by the State Government for consideration of the proposal by the Ministry for final approval'.

Hence, the user agency has given an undertaking regarding the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been applied and is under process and shall be submitted before in-principle approval. (Annexure No.VI)
