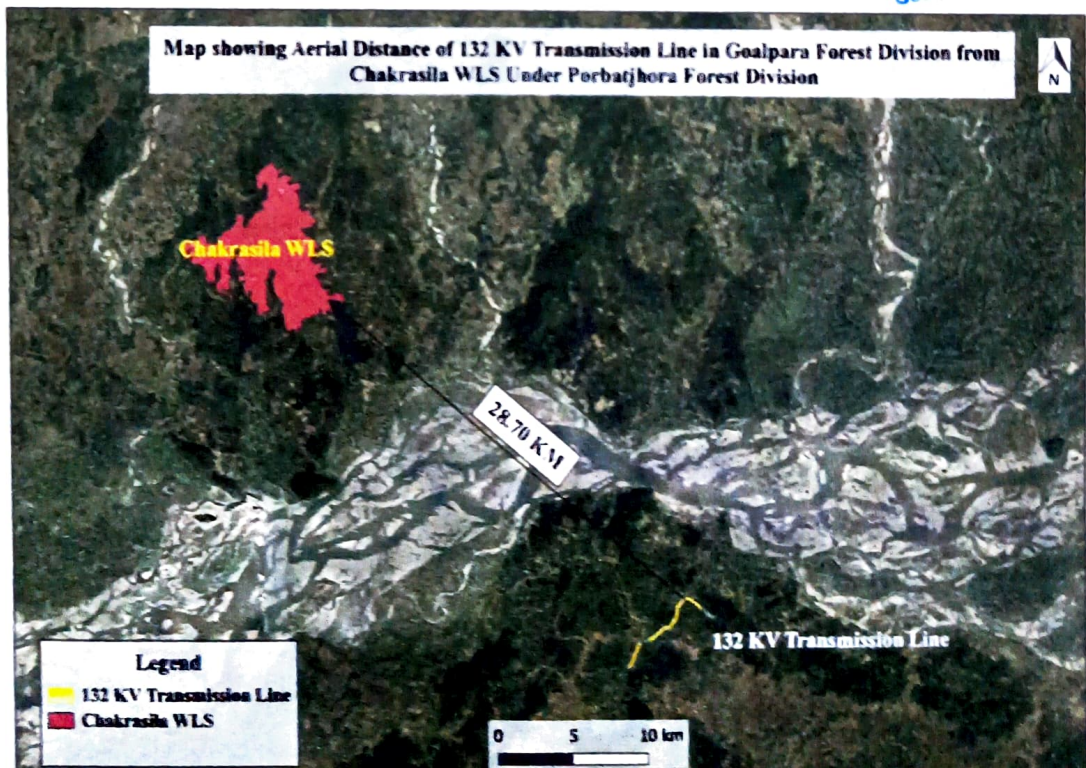
**Distance Certificate of Nearest Tiger Reserve/ Protected Areas from Forest  
Diversion Proposal Area**

**To whom it may concern**

This is to certify that in respect of the proposed 132 KV Transmission Line from Agia TSS passes through Rakshashini PRF under Goalpara Forest Division (T), Goalpara. There are no Tiger Reserve/ National Park/ Wildlife Sanctuary/ Biosphere Reserve falling within the jurisdiction of Goalpara Forest Division, Goalpara. However, the nearest protected area i.e Chakrasila Wild Life Sanctuary under Parbatjhora Forest Division is at an aerial distance of about 28.70 KM from the proposed area to be diverted for the 132 KV Transmission line.

In this connection, a map showing the aerial distance of the proposed area from the nearest Chakrasila Wild Life Sanctuary is enclosed herewith for ready reference.

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11- 9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 18.028 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Railway Electrification for construction of 132 KV Transmission line from Agia GSS to Goalpara TSS in Goalpara district falls within jurisdiction of Rakhyashini PRF village(s) in Balijana tehsils.

It is further certified that :

- (a) the complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire.....hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure .....to .....annexure.....( **Not Applicable**)
- (b) the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it; ( **Not Applicable**)
