2. The certificate regarding cost benefit has been placed in the proposal.

5. The revised check list No. 7 has been placed in the proposal folder.
6. The documents page No. 119 to 169 has been authenticated in the proposal folders.
7. Necessary correction has been done online.
8. Necessary correction has been done online as well as the list of trees coming on the dumping sites has been placed in the proposal folders at page No. ~~142 to 168.~~
9. Necessary correction has been done online.
10. Necessary correction as well as revised KML file has been uploaded online.
11. Necessary certificate has been placed in the proposal folders.
12. The cost estimate for reclamation plan of engineering structures as well as plantation scheme has been placed in the proposal folders.
13. The user agency has reported that " *During the site visit dumping site No.2 spread over an area of 3.1175 ha. was inspected (forest land 2.5702 ha. and non forest land 0.5473 ha.) as mentioned at page No. 199 in the proposal folders. The same may be mentioned in the inspection report. The list of trees has been placed in the proposal folders. As the site inspection report the site may impact water ecology of the of the area but suitable drainage structures like box culverts may be provided to mitigate the impact as there is no suitable land for muck disposal sites. It is further reported that during the site inspection by the undersigned the dumping site No. 2 at UPF 218 Goro it is observed that the proposed dumping site is spread over an area of 3.1175 ha. (2.5702 ha. forest land & 0.5473 ha. non forest land) and involves felling of 816 No. trees & 914 No. saplings, it is further pointed out that the said site is located at the foothills of the catchment area of 3 small streams (seasonal) which may impact the water ecology of the area. Thus the scientific reclamation plan may be imposed on the user agency to keep into consideration the water ecology of the area as well as the impact of the same on the down stream areas.*
