

Thus very less time is available for execution of project work. This project is being monitored in the PMG. Local public and Hon'ble Minister of Panchayati Raj are chasing for early completion of the project without which it is not possible to increase the services of local trains due to over saturated traffic on the existing tracks. Considering the existence of present tracks over a period of more than 163 years it is requested to proceed further as per the report of CFA instead of WII.

In view of above it is requested to kindly sent your comments as sought in point (i) by MoEF & CC vide reference (1) above on the proposed project passing in Eco-Sensitive Zone of Tansa Wildlife Sanctuary.






