

Justification and Recommendation

The forest area for diversion for implementing the proposal of augmentation of water supply scheme in Angamaly Constituency is 0.54208 Ha in the Kalady range of Malayattoor Forest Division. The proposed area does not have any rare/endangered/unique species of flora. No trees are required to be felled for implementing the project. The proposal after implementation will be beneficial to the people residing in the Malayattoor – Neelishwaram Panchayath and Ayyampuzha panchayath. The requirement of the forest land is unavoidable and bare minimum. Hence I recommend 0.54208 Ha forest land for diversion.
