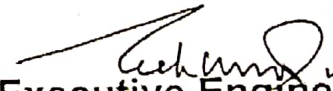

Justification Certificate

The PMGSY road from Ganjote to Phalni Part II has been sanctioned under Package No JK14-572, Stage Ist, Phase XI, Length = 30.24 KM. Out of 30.24 KM of road length, 9.85 KM length of the road falls in forest area which involves 5.91 Hectares land for construction of road and 8.40 Ha. of land is kept for dumping yards. The area/No of dumping yards are kept on higher side than the forest area involved for construction of road to avoid agricultural land for dumping in adjoining areas and to save the forest on downside of the road alignment on steep hill slopes where no scope is available to control the mulba during the earthwork execution of the said road.

Hence, justification certificate is issued keeping in view the safety of agricultural land and forest/Vegetation on downside of the road alignment on steep hill slope.
