Subject: Diversion of 4.9 ha of forest land in favour of HPPWD for the Construction of
Tatta Pani to Khun Salhanu Dhar within the jurisdiction of Seraj at Banjar
Forest Division, distt. Kullu, H.P. Online Proposal No.
FP/HP/ROAD/150507/2021.

Kindly refer to your office letter No. FC/HPB/102/2023 dated 22.12.2023 on
the subject cited proposal.

2. The point-wise reply to the observation as raised vide your above referred
communication is submitted as below:-

1. The User Agency has reported that the name mentioned in the Authority Letter
is of the Engineer -in-Chief. All the Executive Engineers of the HPPWD
Divisions have been authorized by him to apply for Forest clearance on behalf
of the Department.
2. The Administrative approval for the proposed stretch has been uploaded by the
User Agency online Part-I in additional information detail.
3. i) Revised KML in polygon shape has been uploaded in online Part-I.
ii) Revised DGPS Map has been uploaded.
iii) No displacement is proposed in the proposal. At some points the road is
passing in between the houses. But no structure is being removed.
iv) Revised KML in this regard has been uploaded and the alignment beyond
the benefits has been re aligned.
v) Revised KML has been uploaded in online column.
4. A Detailed Report on Alternate examined viz No of trees coming in the
alignment and reason for rejection duly authenticated by concerned DFO has
been uploaded in additional information online Part-I at Sr. No.11.

5. In this regard, it is submitted that khasra Nos are not mentioned for forest land in Kullu Distt. of H.P. However, the Compartment enumeration list of trees alongwith the date of enumeration has been uploaded in addition information of Part-II at Sr. No.6.
6. The Layout Plan in an appropriate scale with all the legends and the proper dimensions of each component, such as Carriageway, Paved Shoulder, Earth Filling, Drain, and Protection Work, as well as area-wise calculations and Forest/Non-Forest area in different colors duly authenticated by the concerned DFO has been uploaded online Part- I in additional information detail at S.No. 16.
7. In this regard User Agency has reported that No Non-Forest land / Private land is available because due to Hilly State the land holding of the people is very less. The people have already donated 1.14 Hec. of their agriculture land for the construction of the road. Hence there is no additional Private Land available. Separate list of trees standing in muck dumping sites has been uploaded in additional information of Part-II at S.No.4.
8. Complete Muck Management Plan along with Engineering Measures and Biological Measures for the effective management of muck generated duly authenticated by the concerned DFO has been uploaded online Part-I in additional Information detail at S.No. 22.
9. An undertaking to provide SMC Plan and to pay its cost as per MoEF &CC guideline dated 07.06.2022 has been uploaded online Part-I in additional Information detail at Sr. No. 24.
- 10 "Geologist Report" for the proposed alignment has been uploaded online Part-I in additional Information detail at Sr. No. 23.
11. In this regard User Agency has reported that no Stream, Nallah, or any other water body is falling in the alignment of the proposed road. An undertaking in this regard has been uploaded online Part-I in additional Information detail at Sr. No.24.
12. The proposal has been examined in detail as per the provisions of the forest (conservation) Act, 1980 Forest conservation Rules 2003 and Guideline & clarification issued on 28.03.2019. The proposed forest land measuring 4.9 ha. Falls in Seraj Forest Division under Pokhardhar & Salhanu (DPF) Protected Forest in which trees enumeration has been carried out and details have been uploaded on the Parivesh 1.0 portal. Instead of proposed diverted land

Compensatory Afforestation has been proposed over 9.8 ha. of 30 Jalora forest in Sojha Beat, Banjar Block, Banjar Range, which is found suitable. The proposal is recommended from forestry point of view subject to compliance of all conditions laid down under the forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and rules made there under. Hence, the proposal is recommended for further consideration.

13. In this regard, it is submitted that the CA site has now been revised, and the revised digital map and toposheet of the CA site have been uploaded online in Part-II.
