The point wise reply the observations is furnished as under :-

- 1. The village wise breakup has been corrected properly by UA in Part-I, Para-B.2-3.
- 2. The area selected for CA is a waste/degraded forest land classified as UPF.
- 3. The revised NPV and Penal NPV calculation sheet in consonance with MoEF & CC order dated 6.1.2022 are enclosed herewith in triplicate.
- 4. The Site inspection of was conducted by the then DFO Bilaspur for old proposed area of 5.5334 ha. Thereafter, as per directions contained in 57<sup>th</sup> REC meeting vide agenda item No. 5, the width of proposed alignment has been reduced according to the existing norms of PMGSY for hill roads due to which area is reduced from 5.5334 ha to 3.9654 ha. Moreover, the length of the road is same as for old proposal. Only width is reduced, as such it seems that there is no need to revise the FRA certificates and site inspection report of DFO. However, recommendation, land suitability certificates etc have been revised.
- 5. UA has submitted certificate that small farmers are living in this area. Due to less private land with rural people, dumping site is given in the forest land.
- 6. The separate enumeration list of trees standing in 11 No. proposed dumping sites is enclosed herewith in triplicate.
- 7. The UA has submitted proper much management plan on prescribed proforma which is sent herewith in triplicate.
- 8. The UA has submitted technical sanction/approval for the project which is sent herewith in triplicate.
