Proposal for diversion of 14.928 ha. of forest land for construction of Sono Barrage Project at Jaida in Baripada & Balasore(WL) Division.

Kindly reference to your above c'ted memo on the captioned subject, the compliance report is submitted here inder on the points raised by Government of India, MOEF & CC, Regional Office, Bhubaneswar vide their letter No.5-ORC307/2017-BHU dt.23.02.2017.

1.The Executive Engineer, Mayurbhar j Investigation Division, Udala vide his letter no. 414 dt.17.04.2017(Copy enclosed) has clarified that Deo Irrigation Project comes under Baitarani Basin where as proposed Sono Irrigation Project is to be constructed in Budhabalanga Basin. Thus both irrigation projects are located on different basin. Neither the basins nor the command areas can be overlapped. A map showing location of the Projects is attached herewith duly signed by the the Executive Engineer, MI Division, Udala and the Divisional Forest Officer, Baripada.

- 2. The Executive Engineer, Mayurbhanj Investigation Division, Udala has reported that Sono Irrigation has both a Ba rage (Non- linear) and Canal System (Linear). As per the provisions of e-filling portal of MOEF&CC,, it has been mentioned as HYBRID project. It can neither be considered specifically a non-linear nor linear Project. Thus, the two different type of FRA certificates have been furnished one for Sono Barrage (Non-linear) another for Canal System (Linear). The Executive Engineer has requested to accept both the certificates as it is a public welfare project.
- 3. The Revised Catchment Area Treatment Plan is now prepared at total cost of Rs.4.42 crores which is 2.05 % of the Project Cost with specific provisions of Biological and Engineering measures including Water Harvesting Structures. The CAT Plan in quadruplicate duly signed by the Divisional Forest Officer, Baripada Division and Executive Engineer, Mayurbhanj Investigation Division, Udala is forwarded herewith for your kird approval.

- 4. The coordinates of the submergence area have been rectified as per the present river course and the corrected shape file in soft copy submitted by the EE, Mayurbhanj Investigation Division, Udala is forwarded herewith for taking necessary action at your end.
- 5. It is a fact that the existing bridge over river Sono in the upstream of the proposed barrage including its approach road of about 180 meters towards Udala and about 60 meters towards Balasore in the pondage area of barrage will be submerged on the proposed barrage as reported by the Executive Engineer, Mayurbhanj Investigation Division, Udala and there is also provision for construction of a high level bridge with its approach road in the DPR to cater the problem.
