Diversion of 4.6147 ha. of forest land in favour of HPPWD for the construction of Gani to Bhorni Nala Road within the jurisdiction of Nachan Forest Division Nachan at Gohar Distt. Mandi, HP.

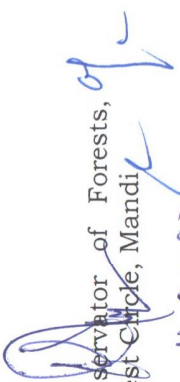
Kindly refer to GoI MOEFCC letter's No. 8B/HP/06/64/2020/FC/794 dated 31.07.2020 addressed to you on the subject cited above.

2. The observations pointed out in the diversion case have been attended. The point wise reply is submitted as under:-

1. The U/A has intimated that the said road is not in the list of 2178 roads as intimated to the Hon'ble High Court Shimla H.P. This road has not been constructed by the Public Works Department so far. It is a bridle path of forest department and construction on this land/proposed road has been done by the Forest Department. इस सम्बन्ध में वन परिक्षेत्र अधिकारी नाचन द्वारा सूचित किया है कि गण्ी से भूरनी नाला तक रास्ते की मुरम्त का कार्य विभाग द्वारा लगभग 17-18 वर्षों से करवाया गया है इसकी मुरम्त के लिए कई वर्षों से धनराशि स्वीकृत की जाती थी व इस रास्ते की मुरम्त का कार्य करवाया जाता था। पंचायत के द्वारा भी इसकी मुरम्त का कार्य किया जाता था।
2. The calculation of Penal NPV has already been attached at Page 92 B in each proposal folder
3. सूचना उपरोक्त मद संख्या 1 में दे दी गई है।
4. The objection has been attended and hard copy attached.
5. U/A has intimated that the villages to be benefited by the proposed road have been marked on the KML file and KML file also been uploaded through online in the web portal.
6. U/A has intimated that in the KML file the proposed alignment is linking two existing roads which is very important, therefore the proposal cannot be revised upto point No. 14 of the geo-referenced map. Because Chail Chowk to Kot Devidarh road and NerChowk to Janjehli road both are already existing roads, which will be connected to the proposed Gani to BhorniNalla road. Hence, this road will provide shortest route to the people of villages; Jachh, Tunna, Bag, Dhangayara, Jahal, Devidarh who otherwise have to travel additional 30 Kilometers to move for Kandha, Bagsaid, Thunag and Janjehli etc. during the emergent conditions as well as for agrarian economy. Therefore, after the construction of this road it will provide the shortest route to aforesaid villages/people on the proposed road which will help saving their time and will also boost the local rural economy.

7. RO Nachan has reported that no trees are involved over the forest land proposed for dumping sites.
8. U/A has intimated that the calculation carried out in Annexure B-I have been corrected in hard copy regarding muck dumping plan and is sent herewith for necessary attachment with the proposal folder.
9. The check list Sr. No. 16 alongwith Digital Map for 4 ha. is enclosed and uploaded online.
10. Necessary certificate is attached.

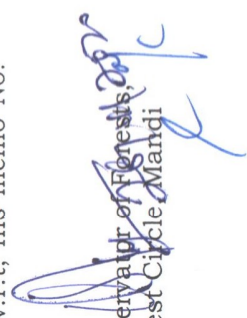
You are, therefore, requested that the necessary approval for the diversion of the above mention forest land may kindly obtained from the competent authority and conveyed to this office.
