Whereas certain areas of village Hara (H.B. No. 394) comprised within the limits of the local areas is notified under Section 3 of the Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900, vide Punjab Government, Notification No. 4868-Ft-IV.60/4938 dated 9th July, 1960.

Whereas Punjab Government while giving effect to the provisions of the Act, imposed certain temporary regulations, restrictions or prohibitions with regard to cutting of trees or timber or the collection, removal or subject to any manufacturing process of any forest produce other than grass, flower, fruit and honey etc. in all private land in village Hara as contained in the Punjab Govt. Notification No. 39 (298) 2005/Ft.3/10591 dated 30/08/05 issued for a period of

30 years under section 4 of the Act in the said village.

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- Whereas the State Government filed an affidavit dated (a) 21.02.1997 detailing action taken for cessation of all non-forest activities in forest areas (both government and private) in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India concerning the interim orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202 of 1995 and a copy of the report regarding details of government/private forests (name, location, area, legal status), details of areas once forests but presently degraded/denuded and details of plantation (government/private) was enclosed with the affidavit as Annexure-G.
- The State Government in the affidavit dated October 1999 (b) submitted that the Expert Committee constituted by the State Government included cultivated/habitation areas closed under Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900 in the list of forest areas only because these areas were included in the Annual Administrative Reports of the Department as "Areas closed under the PLPA, 1900" and the State Government informed and apprised the Hon'ble Supreme Court of the views and in-principle decision of the State Government to delete all those areas closed under PLPA, 1900 which were under cultivation and habitation from the list of forest areas as contained in Annexure-G enclosed with the aforesaid affidavit dated 21.02.1997.
- Whereas on 9.9.2005, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in IA No. 976 in IA No. 727 ordered Ministry of Environment & Forests to consider the proposal of the State of Punjab as contained in communication dated 4th July, 2000 in accordance with the rules procedure and midelines laid down under Forest

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Regional Office (Northern Zone), Chandigarh letter no. 9-PBB-532/2014-CHA dated 27.11.2014 on the above mentioned subject and to say that this Ministry concurs with the opinion of the Regional Office (Northern Zone), Chandigarh that to remove discrimination of land owners of de-listed PLPA land vis-n-vis owners of wher areas closed under PLPA, 1900, in case prior approval of Central Government under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for non-forest use of the de-listed PLPA land is sought by the user agency through State Government, such de-listed areas shall be treated as forest for the purpose of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. However, owner of such land may utilize such delisted PLPA areas for the bonafide use of agriculture and for sustaining livelihood as has been specified in the orders issued by this Ministry for delisting of such areas.

- 5. (a) Whereas in compliance of the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 9.9.2005, Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India vide F.No. 8-19/2006-FC dated 16th March 2006 conveyed in-principle approval to de-list 65,670.26 ha. cultivated and Habitation areas closed under Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900 from the list of forest areas for bonafide agricultural use and other livelihood needs subject to the following conditions:
- i) The State Government shall ensure that no commercial activity is permitted on such de-listed land.
- ii) The de-listed land shall be used only for bonafide use for agriculture and for sustaining the livelihood of the people/owner of the land.
- iii) A detailed list of such lands showing the land use and status of such land before 25.10.1980 and after that, up to 12.12.1996, shall be furnished to this Ministry before final approval.
- (b) Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India vide F.No. 8-19/2006-FC dated 24th July 2009 conveyed approval for de-listing of 55,339.95 ha cultivated and Habitation areas closed under Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900 from the list of forest areas subject to the following conditions:
- i) The State Government shall ensure that no commercial activities are permitted on such de-listed land;
- ii) The de-listed land shall only be used for bonafide use of agriculture and for sustaining the livelihood of the people/owner of the land.
- iii) If inadvertently, any notified or otherwise forest areas are found to have been included in the present list of areas being considered for de-listing, such areas shall not be deemed to have been de-listed from the list of forest areas of the State.
- 6. Therefore, keeping in view the above, in so far as village Hara is concerned, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to delist/denotify the land measuring 1233.54 ha cultivated and Habitation area of village Hara closed under section 4 of PLPA, 1900 comprised in the Khasra numbers as detailed in Annexure-1 and also from the list of forest areas as contained in Annexure-G enclosed with the affidavit dated 21.2.1997 of the State Government in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202 of 1995. Consequently, the restrictions, regulations and prohibitions imposed under Section 4 of PLPA, 1900 shall cease to be applicable in the delisted areas.

- 7. The above deletion is subject to the final judgments in Civil Appeal No. 4682-4683 of 2005 of B.S. Sandhu vs. Government of India and others, Civil Appeal No. 4798 of 2005 of Bhartiya Kisan Union TH. Vice President vs. State of Punjab and others, Civil Appeal No. 4799-4800 of 2005 of Suresh Sharma and others vs. B.S. Sandhu and others, Special leave Petition (Criminal) No. 7647 of 2009 with Criminal Misc. No. 17535 of 2009 of Harsh Kumar Sharma vs. Central Bureau of Investigation and others pending before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

This de-listed area will be administered in accordance with the decisions taken in the meeting held under Chairmanship of Worthy Chief Secretary, Punjab on 26.4.2010 as contained in the proceedings issued vide Punjab Govt. Memo No. 39/578/2005-Forest-3/2945 dated 4-5-2010 (copy enclosed in the Annexure II)

Land Preservation Act, 1900, the Governor of Punjab was pleased to order that the regulations, restrictions and prohibitions mentioned in the Punjab Government Notification No.4868-Ft-IV-60/4939, dated 9th July, 1960, in respect of the areas, which are comprised within the limits of the areas notified under section 3 of the Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900 by the Punjab Government Notification No.4868-Ft-IV-60/4938, dated 9th July, 1960 and mentioned in the schedule appended thereto, shall remain enforced for a period of 15 years in the first instance, with effect from 9.7.1960 and in the second instance the Notification was extended for a period of the 15 years vide Punjab Government Notification No.1784-Ft-III-75/17817 with effect from 10.7.1975 and in third instance the notification was extended for a period of 15 years vide Punjab Government Notification No.39(24)-Ft-III-90/14685, dated 4.7.1990.

And whereas the President of India is satisfied after the enquiry that the regulations, restrictions and prohibitions contained in the aforesaid orders are necessary for a further period of 30 years for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of the said Act.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the said Act and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the President of India is pleased to regulate, restrict or prohibit by this orders the matters mentioned in the notification of Government aforesaid, for a further period of 30 years with effect from 9th July, 2005.
