I submit that the copy of letter received in the reference 6th cited to gather with it's enclosures (Estimates for raising compensatory afforestation over 3.04 Ha in S.No.467/A/2 of Sanamavu Village) is enclosed for Principal Chief Conservator of Forest's Kind perusal.

2) The Wildlife Warden has reported that the Non Forest land selected in S.No.467/A/2 of Sanamavu Village of Soolagiri Taluk of Krishnagiri District is contiguous to the Sanamavu Reserved Forests and found convenient from

management point of view. Hence the Government of India may be informed accordingly.

As regards to Compensatory Afforestation the Wildlife Warden has stated that she has followed the model estimate as already communicated by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in No.TS3/33950/2013 Dated.12-06-2015 and followed the forest schedule of rates for 2022-2023 in force and assessed the total Compensatory Afforestation including 10 year maintenance to Rs.72,18,500/as against the amount of Rs.1,47,49,588/- proposed earlier. It has been added that besides planting activities, for protection of plantation from elephants and other wildlife, hanging solar fence has been proposed to suit the filed condition. This may be informed to the Government of India accordingly to consider the revised Compensatory Afforestation proposal now sent by the Wildlife Warden,
