

- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/Local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.

- c) The each concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/ process under the FRA have been carried out, and they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having under stood the propose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of Kadapatti, Madarakandi, Hulyal & City Municipal Corporation Jamakhandi, are enclosed.
- d) The discussion and decisions on such proposal had taken place only when there was quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;

f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agriculture communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (e) of the

FRA.
