
2. In this connection, it is submitted that the observations as raised vide GoI, MoEF letter under reference have been attended by the User Agency as well as DFO Dalhousie, the point wise reply to the EDS is given as under: -

1. The CA site KML file and Digital Maps has been revised and uploaded on the portal against appropriate column in online Part-II.
2. The Cost Benefit Analysis showing ratio of CBA analysis duly authenticated by DFO has been uploaded against additional information in online Part-I.
3. The record of all consultations and proceedings of FRC/Gram Sabha of all affected villages has been uploaded on the portal by User Agency against additional information.
4. The SMCP is not yet prepared for this area, but the bill as per guidelines (i.e. 0.5% of the total project cost) for taking the soil moisture conservation which to be realized from the user agency against this proposal along with undertaking of user agency to pay the same has been uploaded on the portal against additional information in online Part-II.
5. The WLMP is not yet prepared for this area, but the bill for taking the works of Wildlife Management in the area as per the guidelines against this proposal along with undertaking of user agency to pay the same has been uploaded on the portal against additional information in online Part-II.
