It is submitted that, the Chief Conservator of Forests, Visakhapatnam in the reference 3rd cited has submitted information as desired by the Government in the reference 4th cited. The information is as follows.

The user agency has identified non-forest land over an extent of 24.04 ha in field no.147, Aram village of Dumbriguda (M), Paderu Division for compensatory afforestation purpose for the following (8) road projects.

Out of the above (8) road proposal for which NFL offered for CA, the user agency has submitted proposals in case of sl.no.1 & 2 in PARIVESH 2.0. Out of these two proposal, one proposal at sl.no.2 was submitted to the Government in PARIVESH 2.0 for onward submission to the Gol,MoEF&CC,IRO, Vijayawada for further action. In the remaining 6 proposals which are under process, the user agency has identified non-forest land for the subject proposal which is mentioned at sl.no.8 in PARIVESH 1.0.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Paderu has inspected the non-forest land identified for compensatory Afforestation purpose on 20.01.2022. The CA area is located on northern side of Dumbriguda to Thutangi road in Kandrum beat. The CA land is located at 750 m. away from the Dumbriguda RF (Compt. no.109) which is the nearest RF. The land status of CA land as per revenue records is Kondaporamboku. The CA area is located on top of hill which is fully covered with vegetation and rock boulders. The CA land is rich in biodiversity.

The Non-forest land identified for compensatory afforestation is covered with moderately dense vegetation (Canopy density - 0.5-0.6), there is no scope for taking up Compensatory afforestation in AR model (Block Plantation) in the non-forest land identified for compensatory afforestation land over an extent of 24.04 ha and hence he followed Rule 11 of Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022 for preparing CA scheme for all the above (8) projects (24.04 ha) to have uniformity. For the subject proposal, the Divisional Forest Officer, Paderu has prepared the compact CA scheme to an extent of 3.23 ha to improvement programme under ANR model with a financial out lay of 36.91 lakh for a period of 20 years including 10 years of ANR treatment and 10 years of cost of protection commencement from commencement from 2024-25 to 2043-44 as per Rule-11 of Forest (Conservation) Rules,2022. **CA Scheme, site inspection report of Divisional Forest Officer, Paderu has been uploaded at Nodal Officer level with this covering letter**.

The authenticated map and Survey of India map of non-forest land identified for CA in 1:50,000 are uploaded in the web portal.

Government are requested to take necessary action for onward submission of additional information to Government of India, MoEF &CC, RO, Sub-office at Vijayawada to accord forest clearance under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and amendments therein as deemed fit in the matter.

In continuation of the reference cited, It is submitted that in the reference 2nd cited the CA scheme proposals were submitted to the Chief Conservator of Forests, Visakhapatnam for Authenticated CA land of 3.11 ha of diversion of 3.23 ha for formation of road from Chowdepalli to Jerrila of Chinthapalli Division.

Further in the reference 3rd cited the Chief Conservator of Forests, Visakhapatnam has approved the CA scheme for Rs. 40.62 lakh and the same was uploaded in parvish portal for further process along with Part-II.The details of road proposals are as follows.

In the reference 4^{th} cited the PCCF (HoFF), Mangalari, A.P., has pointed out some shortcomings i.e. as per Rule – 11 of Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022 says that "if the non-forest land being made available for Compensatory Afforestation already bears vegetation of 0.4"

canopy density or more, there shall not be an additional requirement of planting of trees on such land but a programme for improvement of the forest crop shall be implemented by the Forest Department in a time bound manner. Hence improvement scheme for the NFL area having canopy density of 0.5 to 0.6 shall be prepared. Further, it is also informed that, if such land bears vegetation of specified density 0.4 or above, there shall not be any requirement of planting trees. Hence DFL selection base on inability to plant 1000 plants/ha to having such density may not be required.

In this connection, I submit that the Revised CA scheme proposals excluding the costof raising of AR plantation and its maintenance and including the forest improvement measures under ANR model along with data for favour of kind information and requesting for approval of the proposed CA scheme for taking further action in this mater. The details of road proposals are as follows.

Detailed CA Scheme prepared for Compensatory Afforestation land of 3.23

ha extent in Arama Village of Dumbriguda Mandal in lieu of the diversion of
forest land for formation of Ebulam Pedavalasa to Suravaram road

Compensatory Afforestation land is identified in field no. 147 of Arama village of Dumbriguda mandal in lieu of the diversion of forest land for various (8) roads in Chintapalli Division.

A single parcel of CA land to the extent of 24.01 ha has been identified and the area is broken up into eight bits equivalent to the size of forest land diverted for the road proposals. Accordingly, the DGPS survey was conducted for each of the eight bits and also for the entire CA area. Compensatory Afforestation land identified in lieu of the diversion of forest land for formation of **Ebulam Pedavalasa to Suravaram** road in Chintapalli Division (erstwhile Narsipatnam Division) also forms part of total CA land area identified in field no. 147 of Arama village of Dumbriguda mandal

The details of the CA area is given below:

CA land location details:

- The CA area is located on northern side of Dumbriguda to Thutangi road in Kandrum beat. The CA land is located at 750 mts away from the Dumbriguda RF (Compt no. 109) which is the nearest reserve forest.
- The CA land is surrounded by Paridi village on Northern side, A.
 Nandivalasa village on the southern side and Badimela on the western side, Musiri and Tundrumguda villages on Northwestern side. These villagers are dependent on this forest for cattle grazing and minor forest produce collection.

Nature of CA land:

- The CA area is located on top of hill which is fully covered with vegetation and rock boulders. The status of CA land as per revenue records is Konda poramboku.
- The gradient is steep.
- There are no pattas / RoFR title deeds in the CA land and it is free from encumbrance.

Type of Vegetation:

• The CA land is fully covered with vegetation. The forest type is moist mixed deciduous type with canopy density of 0.5 – 0.6. The CA land is rich in biodiversity. The prominent floral species present in the area are Nalla maddi, Jamun, Nalla jeedi, Karaka, Thani, Gannara, Sandalwood, Mango and other miscellaneous species. The vegetation is present in three tiers. The top tier is occupied by Mango, Jamun, Adda leaf lianas and the middle tier is occupied by Sandal wood, Nalla jeedi, Karaka, Thani, Gannara etc. The lower tier is covered with

Curry leaf, *Lantana*, *Eupatorium* and a very few xerophytic species in the rocky areas.

Details of CA Scheme:

The CA Scheme is prepared by keeping the location, topography and vegetation factors of CA land and Forest Conservation Rules and Guidelines of Forest Conservation Act in mind as given below:

- As the area is covered with moderately dense vegetation (Canopy density - 0.5-0.6), there is no scope for taking up Compensatory afforestation in AR model (Block Plantation).
- As per Rule 11(1)(a) of Forest Conservation Rules, 2022 if the non-forest land being made available for Compensatory Afforestation already bears vegetation of 0.4 canopy density or more, there shall not be an additional requirement of planting of trees on such land but a programme for improvement of the forest crop shall be implemented by the Forest Department in a time-bound manner.
- Therefore, afforestation work under AR model is not proposed in the CA scheme. But a forest improvement programme under ANR model is proposed in the CA Scheme.

Improvement of forest under ANR model:

- Two types of operations are proposed under ANR model
 - 1. Operations such as removal of unwanted miscellaneous growth including thorny growth interfering with the natural regeneration of viable species, Singling of multiple shoots, Coppice cutting, high stump cutting, climber cutting and cutting back damaged trees. This operation is proposed three times

only @ once in three years mainly to rejuvenate the existing stock.

2. Various cultural operations for assisting the natural rejuvenation of existing seedlings - Saucer formation, Circular weeding (2 times) and Soil Working (one time) operations are proposed for 10 year period in the CA scheme so as to promote the growth and natural regeneration of important species.

Protection Works:

- As the CA land is surrounded by Badimela, Tumbruguda,
 A.Nandivalasa, Paridi and Musiri villages, the protection has to be
 provided to this area from all biotic interference i.e. cattle grazing and
 tree felling. For this, construction of boundary pillars (12 no.) around
 the entire area of CA land, Barbed Wire fencing (340 Rmt) followed by
 digging of cattle proof trench (425 cum) are proposed in the CA
 scheme so as to provide protection to the area.
- Further fire lines creation and its maintenance & maintenance works of barbed wire fencing and Boundary pillars and one watch and ward are provided for 20 years (10 years of ANR treatment and 10 years of cost of protection) under cost of protection in the CA scheme as per the Forest Conservation Rules, 2022.
- As the gradient is steep, this area is suitable for taking up SMC works particularly Continuous Contour Trenches to control the Soil & water erosion. Therefore CCT/SCT works (124 Cum) of dimension 10x0.5x0.5 m³ are proposed in the CA scheme.
- Rough stone dry packing works (75 Cum) are also proposed across the Nallah/slope to conserve the soil.

- This CA-land with moderately dense vegetation is being accepted as there is no other degraded revenue areas available in the erstwhile Visakhapatnam district.
- The CA land area will be included under Biodiversity Management Working Circle in the Working Plan of Paderu Division.

The total amount of action plan for CA Scheme including SMC Works and Cost of Protection is Rs **36,91,000**/-.



Site Inspection Report of the Divisional Forest Officer, Paderu for on Compensatory Afforestation land of 1.98 ha in lieu of diversion of 1.90 ha of forest land for formation of road Chowdepalli to Jerrila on 20.01.2022.

 Inspected the Compensatory Afforestation (CA) land identified in field no. 147 of Arama village of Dumbriguda mandal along with Forest Range Officer, Araku, Forest Section Officer, Guntaseema and other staff.





- The CA area is located on northern side of Dumbriguda to Thutangi road in Kandrum beat.
 The CA land is located at 750 mts away from the Dumbriguda RF (Compt no. 109) which is
 the nearest reserve forest. The land status of CA land as per revenue records is Konda
 Poramboku.
- The CA land is surrounded by Paridi on Northern side, A. Nandivalasa village on the southern side and Badimela on the western side, Musiri and Tundrumguda villages on Northwestern side. These villagers are dependent on this forest for cattle grazing and minor forest produce collection.
- The CA area is located on top of hill which is fully covered with vegetation and rock boulders. The forest type is moist mixed deciduous type with canopy density of 0.5 0.6. The CA land is rich in biodiversity. The prominent floral species present in the area are Nalla maddi, Jamun, Nalla jeedi, Karaka, Thani, Gannara, Sandalwood, Mango and other miscellaneous species. The vegetation is present in three tiers. The top tier is occupied by Mango, Jamun, Adda leaf lianas and the middle tier is occupied by Sandal wood, Nallajeedi, Karaka, Thani, Gannara etc. The lower tier is covered with Curry leaf, Lantana, Eupatorium and a very few xerophytic species in the rocky areas.
- The gradient of land is steep slope
- There are no encumbrances/ RoFR patta titles awarded in the CA land.

- The CA area is not suitable for taking up any afforestation activity (block plantation) as the area is covered with vegetation. Therefore the Compensatory afforestation will be taken up in other equivalent Degraded Forest Land which is identified in compartment no. 89 of Neelamkonda RF of Guntaseema beat Guntaseema Section, Araku Range. (Total degraded forest land identified is 28.56 ha out of which 1.90 ha is earmarked for taking up NTSH block plantation)
- This area is suitable for taking up SMC works particularly Continuous Contour Trenches/ Staggered Contour Trenches to control the Soil & water erosion.
- As the CA land is surrounded by villages, this area has to be protected from all biotic interference particularly from the cattle grazing and tree felling.
- This CA land with moderately dense vegetation is being accepted as there is no other degraded revenue areas available in the Visakhapatnam district.
- The CA land area will be included under Biodiversity Management Working Circle in the Working Plan of Paderu Division.
