In reply to point No. 4; it has been stated that "User Agency has intimated that there are no trees standing in the proposed dumping site" whereas detail of trees should be submitted by DFO concerned and report in this regard should be self-explanatory.	In this respect, it is submitted that the Spot has been Inspected by the concerned Range Forest Officer under which the proposed diversion area falls and during the Spot Inspection, it has been found that there are no green trees standing upon the area proposed as Dumping Site, please. The Copy of the Site Inspection conducted by the Range Forest Officer concerned has been uploaded online on Parivesh portal in the Part-II under Additional Information Details, please.
2.	In reply to point No 7 & 18, is not correct, as the KML file should contain all information as asked by GoI.	In this respect, the User Agency has submitted the Layout Plan & KML file showing all the components (Forest Land/ Non-Forest Land/ Violated Part) with the distinct colours duly authenticated by the DFO concerned as well as uploaded online on Parivesh portal in the Part-I under appropriate column and under Additional Information Details, please.
3.	In reply to point No. 12, Fresh joint inspection report state to have been uploaded in part.II but no such reports.	In this respect, it is submitted that the Fresh Joint Inspection report has been uploaded by the User Agency through online on Parivesh portal in the Part-I under Additional Information Details at Sl. No. 24 as "Fresh Joint inspection Report", please.
