Subject: Diversion of 2.8573 ha. of forest Land in favour of M/s Hydro More Power Pvt. Ltd. TRV Building Sector-II New Shimla for the construction of 2.00 MW Tranh-Charoli SHEP, within the Jurisdiction of Chopal Forest Division, District Shimla, Himachal Pradesh.( FP/HP/HYD/26220/2017)

Memo: Kindly refer to your office letter No. Ft. 48-3768/2018(FCA) dated 12.10.2023 on the subject cited above.

2. The point wise reply is given as under:-

Sr.	Observations	Reply
1.	As per KML file all component as per component wise breakup has not been marked in KML file whereas it should be marked alongwith the private land in the legend in different colour. Further, village to be benefitted has also not been found marked in KML file. The power evacuation plan has not been found uploaded in Part-I, Further, 810 meter transmission line having 18 width has been proposed, but carrying capacity of transmission line has not been given.	Revised KML file showing all the components, benefitted villages and Private land marked and it has been uploaded on the Portal by the User Agency. Power evacuation Plan shall be generated at 3.0 KV, stepped -up to 22KV outdoor pole mounted step up transformer and switchgear to match the existing 22 KV grid of HPSEB.
2.	The name of forest has been mentioned in Para 2 instead of giving the detail of legal status of area.	The name of the forest and the illegal status of forest have been mentioned now on Part-II.
3.	As per the Para 5 of Part-II, the proposal forest land prescribed for Deodar and Kail working circle as per old approved working plan which was valid up to 2017-18. The latest status of proposed land as per approved working plan from 2017 -18 onward may be given.	In this respect, DFO Chopal has submitted that the latest working plan of Chopal Forest Division has not been made till date.
4.	As per MoEF & CC Directions give on 13.05.2022 for all the Hydel Projects of Himachal Pradesh , the following additional documents/information are also required:-	Detailed list of approved/existing proposed project in the River Basin area/landscape showing the power evacuation/Transmission plan of each HEP along with their impacts on the ecology of the area has been uploaded on the portal by the user agency against additional information at Sr. No. - 24.
	(i) Detailed list of approved /existing proposed projects in the River Basin Area/Landscape showing the Power Evacuation/Transmission Plan of each HEP along with their impacts on the ecology of

9.	In Part-II, it has been mentioned that proposed land is prescribed for Deodar, Kail Working Circle as per previous working plan. Therefore, the State Govt. may provide the prescription of proposed Working Plan for the diversion area.	The proposed land is prescribed for Deodar, Kail Working Circle as per previous working plan has been uploaded against additional detail column No. 13 in Part-II.
10.	It has been submitted that entire muck will be used in the diversion area for different activities. Therefore, the State Govt. may provide Muck Management Plan (MMP) mentioning the estimated muck to be generated including soil swell factor and muck to be utilized. Further, the MMP shall be duly countersign by the concerned DFO.	Muck management plan has been uploaded on the portal against additional information detail at Sr. No. 21 part-I.
11.	CA scheme of 1978 plants is required. Therefore, CA scheme shall be revised as per 1978 plants and also it may ensured recent wage rates has been considered for preparing the CA Scheme.	CA scheme of 1978 plants has been prepared and uploaded in the appropriate column in 13(ii) in Part-II.
12.	NPV bill calculation sheet is required to be revised as per recent rates of MoEF&CC letter dard 6th January, 2022.	The revised Bill of NPV has been uploaded against additional detail column No. 15.
13.	FRA has been submitted. However, the records and annexures of consultations and proceedings of FRC and Gram Sabha of all villages may be provided/ uploaded.	Complete FRA Certificate has been uploaded on the portal against Column No. K (a) in part-I by the user agency.
14.	The project is proposed in a hilly terrain, therefore, the accelerated soil erosion during and after completion of the project will be inevitable. Therefore, the State Govt. is required to submit the Soil and Moisture Conservation Plan (SMCP) as per recent direction of MoEF&CC vide letter dated 7 <sup>th</sup> June, 2022.	Various mitigation measures will be adopted during and after execution of the project like, construction of R/Wall and B/wall etc. also, the cost of SMCP will be paid as per the guidelines i.e. 0.5% of the Total Project cost as and when demanded by the forest department. Undertaking to this effect has been uploaded at Sr. No. 17 against additional information detail part-I by the user agency. AND Bill of SMCP has been uploaded against additional detail column No. 12 by the DCF.
15.	Consent to Establish may be obtained from Himachal Pradesh State Pollution Control Board (HPSPCB) before Stage II approval. Undertaking to provide the same is required to be submitted.	User Agency has given an undertaking to provide consent of HPSPCB has been uploaded on the portal at Sr. No. 16 against additional information detail in part-I.
16.	Legal status of proposed CA land, whether it is a forest land as per IFA 1927 under the control of State Forest Department or it is a waste land declared as Protected Forest under 1952 notification of HP Government, shall be clarified.	The legal status of proposed CA area has been uploaded against additional detail column No. 11 in Part-II.
