The Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, New Delhi vide letter under reference No. 1 has raised back query on 14 points. Accordingly, the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Mangrove Cell, Mumbai vide letter under reference No. 2 has submitted the compliance report to this office. The Chief Conservator of Forests (T). Pune vide letter dated 11/03/2025 has submitted compliance as under:-

It is true that M/s Essar Steel India Pvt. Ltd. was the erstwhile user agency to submit the proposal for diversion of 0.1305 ha of forest land. M/s Essar Steel India Pvt. Ltd. had submitted the proposal to the Forest Department through proper channel. As Essar Steel India Pvt. Ltd. had already laid pipeline in Reserved Forest Gut No.152 to 155 at Village Koregaon Bhima, Dhingrajwadi, Taluka-Shirur Hence, it was treated as violation proposal.

New Project Proponent M/s Arcelor Mittal Nippon Steel India I imited took over M/s Essar Steel India Pvt. Ltd. company and the proposal for diversion of 0.1305 Ha. of forest land was forwarded by the new company. In the visit of team of the Regional Office, Nagpur, MoEF&CC including Shri.Senthil Kumar (DDGS) and Shri.Tashildar (AIGF), the CCF Pune visited proposed site on 18th December, 2024.

In the inspection, it was confirmed that old pipeline laid by erstwhile user agency i.e M's Lssar Steel India Pvt. Ltd. was disconnected.

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prior to submission of the proposal no.FP/MH/IND/20151/2016.

Now, after inspection by the team dated 18th December, 2024 it is confirmed that the proposal is new one by project proponent is M/s Arcelor Mittal Nippon Steel India Limited who have submitted instant proposal. This may be treated as fresh proposal by M/s Arcelor Mittal Nippon Steel India Limited.

The present project proponent is M/s Arcelor Mittal Nippon Steel India Limited. The user agency has complied with all the queries raised. The proposal is now recommended for prior approval of Central Government U/s. 2 (I) (II) of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for non-forestry use of 0.1305 Ha of forest land in favour of M/s Arcelor Mittal Nippon Steel India Limited Sanaswadi, for laying underground water pipeline for industrial use and drinking water purpose.

The user agency had lodge W.P No 11426/2016, wherein Hon'ble High Court Mumbai vide dated 20/10/2016 directed to submit the proposal to the Central Govt through proper channel. This needs nore clarification along with present status of court natter needs submission.

The Dy.CF, Junnar and CCF (T), Pune vide letter dated 31/12/2024 & 10/01/2025 has submitted compliance report as follows:-

It is true that aggrieved by unilateral action of removing, disconnecting & throwing away underground water pipeline earlier, User Agency M/s. Essar Steel India Pvt. Ltd. had lodged W.P No 11426/2016.

As per the directions of Hon'ble High Court, Mumbai on October 20, 2016 M/s. Essar Steel India Pvt. Ltd submitted the proposal to the forest department through proper channels.

As the Hon'ble High Court, Mumbai has disposed off the above said W.P No 11426/2016 therefore no matter is pending regarding this issue in the any other court in India. As per court order the proposal is submitted (Copy of the judgment date October 20, 2016 enclosed herewith).

The CA scheme was prepared in the year 2018. Therefore, rev sed CA scheme as per current wage needs submiss on.

The Dy.CF, Junnar and CCF (T), Pune vide letter dated 31/12/2024 & 10/01/2025 has submitted compliance report as follows:-

The State Govt. has reported that the in the year 1999 the Forest Department has taken the possession of Gut Nos 152 to 155 from the revenue department and at present the legal status of proposed forest land reported as Reserve Forest. Therefore, shifting in the ownership of land from one department to another needs more clarification. Whether such ownership transfer was part of any forest diversion proposal. The factual position in this regard needs justification along with the copies of RF notification by the State Govt. needs submission.

The CCF (Γ), Pune recommended the proposal subject to a condition that the user agency should raise 25 ha of Irrigated plantation under CSR through tripartite agreement.

The project proponent formerly Shree Precoated Steels Ltd., has contributed to the forest conservation and plantation in the past in the year 2003 and the present user agency has assured that they will share their responsibility in future as and when required. But this condition is not acceptable to the project proponent as a precondition for diversion of forest land 0.1305 ha. as per their reply to query.

The Dy.CF, Junnar and CCF (T). Pune vide letter dated 31/12/2024 & 10/01/2025 has submitted | compliance report as follows:-

The instant proposal involved violation of FC Act 1980 by M/s. Essar Steel India Pvt. Ltd. prior to the year 1988-89 when the land was in possession of revenue department.

The encroachment was removed by forest department in the year 1999 when they took over the possession of the said land. The offense was registered against M/s. Essar Steel India Pvt. Ltd. and fine of Rs. 5,000/- was recovered under IFA 1927.

Therefore, action is taken by the State Govt under the provisions of IFA 1927. Hence the action under FCA 1980 is not required in this case.

The FC Act proposes action against only govt officers and other govt agencies not against private person or organization. It is requested that not this proposal may be considered as a proposal seeking prior approval from the Central Govt, as no pipeline is laid and the previous pipeline was already removed. The present project proponent can not be held responsible for the violation which was not done by M/s. Essar Steel India Pvt. Ltd. & this is a very old case which is already disposed off under
