

### JUSTIFICATION OF THE LOCATION OF PROJECT IN FOREST AREA

The Project, 22 KV D/C Transmission line shall start from Tangnu Romai-II HEP (6MW) Power House to 22/66 KV Andhra Sub-Station bay of HPSEBL at Chirgaon. The total length of the line will be 20.6 KM. This 22 KV D/C Transmission line will carry 6 MW of Power and inject in to HPSEBL system for further distribution of the same in the vicinity of the Chirgaon and Rohru and remaining power will be evacuated through 66 KV line from Andhra to Nogli and Nogli to Kotla for further distribution in HPSEBL system.

The transmission line is linear project and all possible steps are taken to avoid the route alignment through forests. In case it becomes unavoidable due to geography of the terrain, the alignment is made in such a way that the route through the forest is barest minimum, however the Forest and Private Land has been traversed through as required necessarily as there is no escape from passing the transmission line through forest area. Transmission Line projects are environmentally friendly and do not involve disposal of solid effluents and hazardous substances in land, air or water. Therefore the project is quite necessary and justified.

Three routes were explored for laying the transmission line and all routes have to necessarily pass through forest area as there is no escape from using the forest land for the construction of said Transmission line. Out of the three routes, Route no. 1 which involves overall minimum forest land/length and minimum number of trees as compared to the other routes has been finalized. It is further mentioned here that Route no. 2 and Route no. 3 have been explored but same having more involvement of forest land and technically not suitable, hence these routes were not considered during Joint inspection. So requirement submitted for diversion which is barest minimum and best suitable for the purpose as no other suitable route is available in the area. Therefore Route no.1 is finalized for Construction of Proposed Transmission line.

Since there is no alternate transmission line to evacuate the power of 6 MW from the project to Andhra Power House at Chirgaon, so construction of transmission line is mandatory.

It is recommended that the proposed proposal for diversion of 22.6664 hac of forest land for the Construction of 22 KV- D/C Transmission Line from Tangnu Romzi-II HEP (6MW) Power House to Andhra Sub-Station of HPS/EBL at Chirgaon may kindly be approved.
