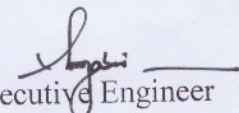

Hence, it is once again requested that the legal status may kindly be changed at your end please and further necessary action may please be taken at your end please.

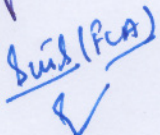

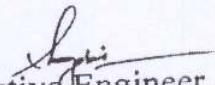

Madam,

With regard to the subject cited above and as intimated by the Range Officer Wildlife Range Udhampur vide his office letter No. 825/ROU dated 25-03-2022, that afore-mentioned road proposal under consideration with concerned quarter envisages widening of existing Mantlail to Dudu road by a resultant width of 4 m for a stretch of 700 m passing through the Forest Co.110c/D of Dudu Forest Range which is in a close proximity to Co.109 of Sudhmahadev Conservation Reserve. Since vehicular movement on this road (with existing width of 6m) is already in operation, the proposed project is unlikely to exert or more precisely add any significant impact on the Conservation Reserve. However, to check and mitigate the plausible impact(s) in terms of vehicle associated mortality that may affect the wildlife, out of wilderness, while incidentally locomoting to cross over the proposed stretch of road project, it is therefore requested/suggested that the following measures are to be incorporated in the Detailed Project Report by the concerned executing agency: -

1. Cautionary/warning sign boards must be provided at regular intervals preferably on every 200 mtrs. and on curves along the road passing through forest.
2. Road studs/reflectors/speed breakers must be provided at suitable intermittent spots preferably after every 300 mtrs.
3. Drainage ditches and retaining/breast walls to be commissioned in the under lying road stretch must be suitably architected to remain environment and wildlife friendly and in a facilitating mode for easy and safe crossing of wildlife.
4. Underpasses through the area are required to be designed in such a way that prominent wildlife of the area can pass through these.

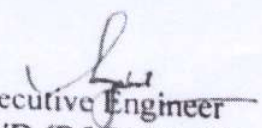

Adverting to the subject captioned above, in this context, as reported by the AEE PWD (R&B) Sub Division, Udhampur vide his office letter No. SEU/968-69 dated 20.12.2021 that EDS has been raised by Chief Conservator for Forest Nodal Officer (FCA) vide letter No. PCCF/FCA/3382/4226-28 dated 14.12.2020, that the total length of purposed road is 5.00 Km. But it is to be intimated that 4.30 Km E/work, GSB, WBM G-II has leady completed whereas the road length which passes through forest area is 700 Mtr. and the quantity of Earthwork for cutting as per quantity is 2000 Cum whereas the quantity for filling chart of earth work on the road surface falling in the forest area shall be, as per L-section of road in Km 3rd RD 250 to Km 4th RD 175. The total qty for filling required is 1039 Cum used as per DPR is 1000 Cum about 500 Cum shall be back filled to R/walls & Approaches of culverts, the balance 500 Cum shall be laid in two stretches in sinking zones of the road i.e Km 2nd RD 100-250 & Km 4th RD 750-875. Thus the proposal for muck disposal yard has not been kept in the proposal.

Hence reply in respect of the EDS raised may kindly be forwarded to concerned at an earliest for want of NOC.
