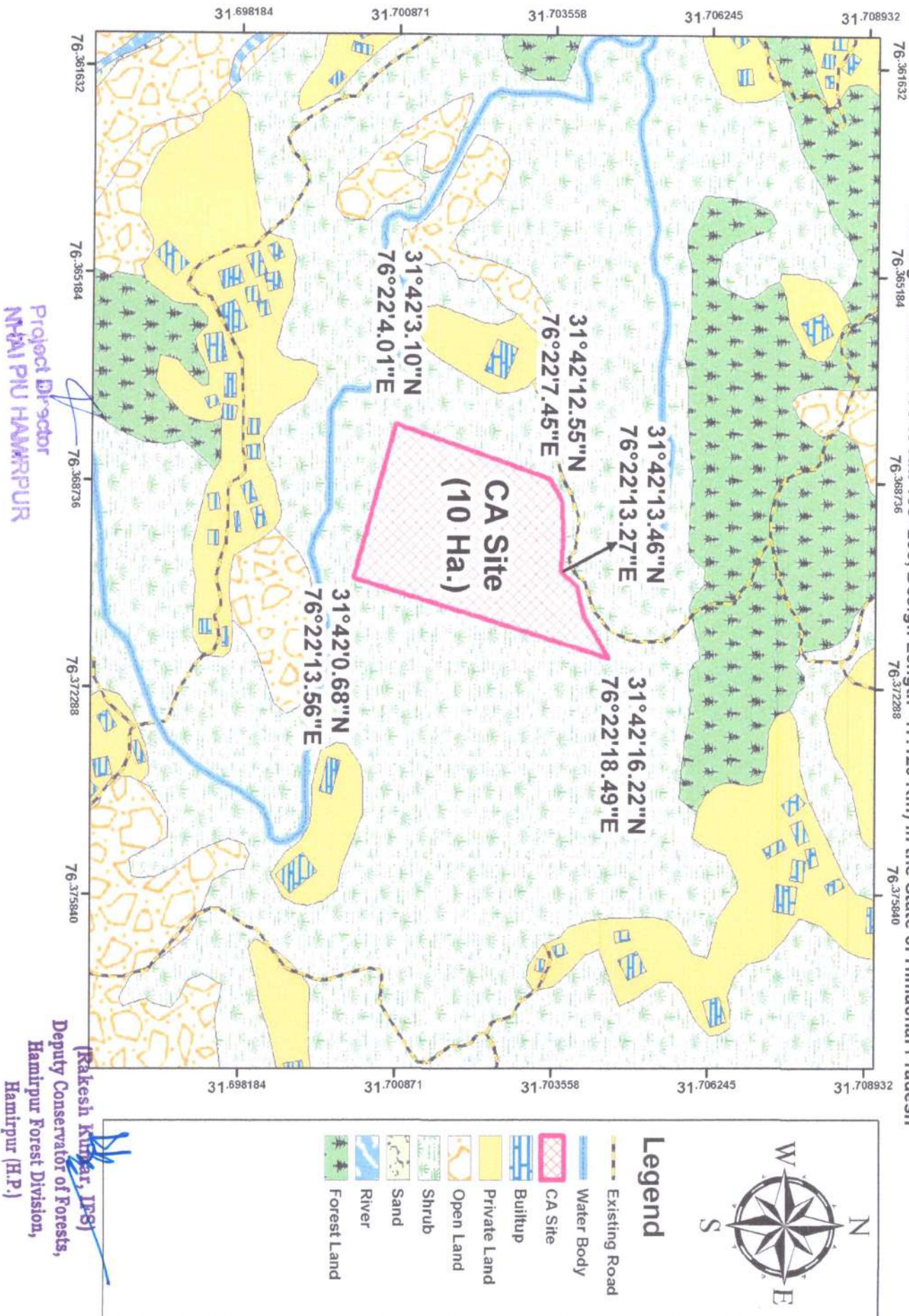

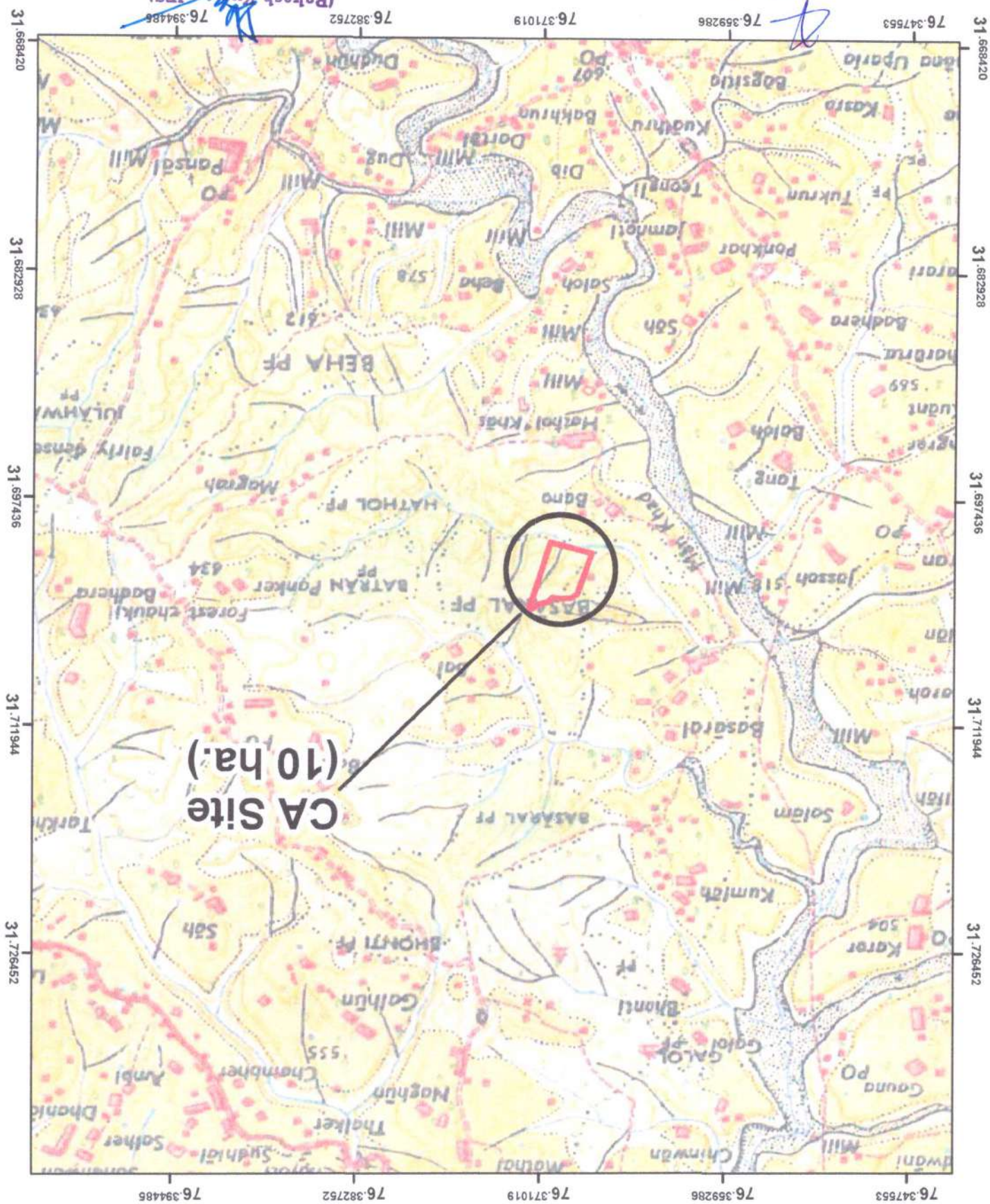
DIGITAL LAND USE MAP
