With Reference to the above cited subject, vide ref (2) and (4) EDS query has been received regarding the forest proposal No: FP/KR/TRANS/42309/2019 pertaining to Rediversion of 4.1294 Ha of forest land and diversion of 3.4007 Ha of forest land required for the transmission line work of Upper Bhadra Project, Package-1 work. The EDS query was

forwarded to user agency and compliance has been received vide ref (6). User agency has submitted the details of alternate alignment routes and legible map of the proposed scheme. The user agency has also uploaded the compliance report in the Parivesh portal.
